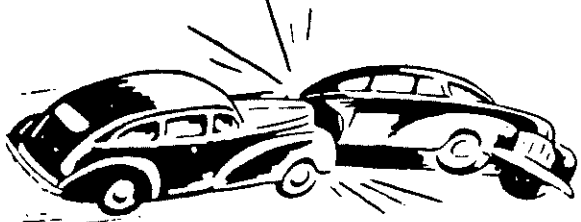

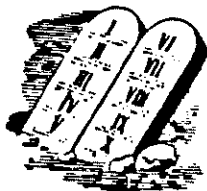

POLIO CLINIC

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 27, AT BISHOP SCHOOL, SUNNYVALE AVE. AT MAUDE AVE. 2:00 - 4:00 P.M.

FIRST, SECOND, THIRD, AND FOURTH INJECTIONS OF SALK VACCINE WILL BE GIVEN TO ADULTS AS WELL AS CHILDREN. WRITTEN PERMISSION MUST BE GIVEN FOR THE POLIO VACCINATION OF A MINOR. CHILDREN UNDER 12 SHOULD BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN. THOSE OVER 12 NEED NOT BE ACCOMPANIED, BUT MUST BRING A SIGNED STATEMENT OF CONSENT. THE FIRST AND SECOND INJECTION SHOULD BE SEPARATED BY FOUR TO SIX WEEKS. THE THIRD INJECTION SHOULD BE RECEIVED 7 TO 12 MONTHS AFTER THE SECOND. IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE FOURTH INJECTION BE GIVEN NOT LESS THAN 1 YEAR AFTER THE THIRD.
