CHILDREN UNDER 12 SHOULD BE ACCOMP-ANIED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN. THOSE OVER 12 NEED NOT BE ACCOMPANIED. BUT MUST BRING A SIGNED STATEMENT OF CON-SENT. THE FIRST AND SECOND INJECTION SHOULD BE SEPARATED BY FOUR TO SIX WEEKS. THE THIRD INJECTION SHOULD BE RECEIVED 7 TO 12 MONTHS AFTER SECOND. IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE FOURTH INJECTION BE GIVEN NOT LESS THAN 1 YEAR AFTER THE THIRD.

## S THE LAW



EXCERPTS FROM ORDINANCE No. 258 PERTAINING TO ANIMALS.

SECTION 8. ANIMALS TRESPASSING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY. ANY ANIMAL OR FOWL FOUND TRESPASSING UPON ANY PRIVATE PROPERTY IN THE CITY MAY BE TAKEN UP BY AND PERSON AND COMMITTED TO THE CUSTODY OF THE MARSHAL; THE FEES PRESCRIBED HEREIN SHALL BE APPLICABLE AS IN OTHER CASES OF IMPOUNDING; AND IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR THE OWNER OR KEEPER, AFTER RECEIVING WRITTEN NOTICE THAT AN ANIMAL OR FOWL IS TRESPASSING UPON ANY PRIVATE PROPERTY, TO ALLOW SAID ANIMAL OR FOWL TO CONTINUE TO TRESPASSO

SECTION 39. UNLAWFUL TO ALLOW ANI-MALS TO RUN AT LARGE. NO OWNER OR PERSON HAVING CONTROL OF ANY ANIMAL MENTIONED IN THIS ORDINANCE.....,

EXCERPTS FROM ORDINANCE NO. 41; GENERALLY CALLED A CURFEW ORDINANCE.

SEC. 1. IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 14 YEARS TO BE UPON ANY OF THE PUBLIC STREETS..., UNATTENDED BY ITS PARENTS OR GUARDIAN AFTER THE HOUR OF 8:30 PM, DURING THE MONTHS BEGINNING OCTOBER 1ST, AND ENDING APRIL 30TH OF EACH AND EVERY YEAR, AND AFTER THE HOUR OF 9 O'CLOCK P.M. DURING THE MONTHS BEGINNING MAY 1ST AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30TH, OF EACH YEAR.


