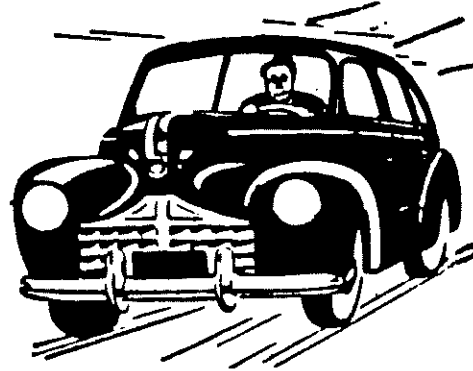

### POLIO CLINIC

FOURTH TUESDAY OF EACH MONTH 2-4 PM. AT BISHOP SCHOOL, SUNNYVALE AVE. AT MAUDE AVE. NEXT CLINIC NOVEMBER 24.

FIRST, SECOND, THIRD, AND FOURTH INJECTIONS OF SALK VACCINE WILL BE GIVEN TO ADULTS AS WELL AS CHILDREN. WRITTEN PERMISSION MUST BE GIVEN FOR THE POLIO VACCINATION OF A MINOR. CHILDREN UNDER 12 SHOULD BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN. THOSE OVER 12 NEED NOT BE ACCOMPANIED, BUT MUST BRING A SIGNED STATEMENT OF CONSENT. THE FIRST AND SECOND INJECTION SHOULD BE SEPARATED BY FOUR TO SIX WEEKS. THE THIRD INJECTION SHOULD BE RECEIVED 7 TO 12 MONTHS AFTER THE SECOND. IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE FOURTH INJECTION BE GIVEN NOT LESS THAN 1 YEAR AFTER THE THIRD.

## EXECUTIVE BOARD REPORT

IN THE NOT TOO DISTANT FUTURE TWO PETITIONS WILL BE CIRCULATED IN LAKE WOOD VILLAGE. BOTH DEAL WITH VERY REAL AND CURRENT PROBLEMS.

THE FIRST IS DESIGNED TO UP-DATE THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CLOVERLEAF AT THE INTERSECTION OF BAYSHORE AND LAWRENCE STATION RD. WE DON'T BELIEVE IT IS NECESSARY TO INDICATE THE IMPORTANCE OF THIS ISSUE, WHEN WE'RE ALL AWARE OF THE FREQUENCY OF ACCIDENTS THAT OCCUR AT THIS INTERSECTION.

THE SECOND ISSUE IS A PETITION DIRECTED AT THE CITY OF SUNNYVALE INDICATING TO THEM OUR PLIGHT AS FAR AS THE SCHOOL SITUATION IS CONCERNED. HOW MANY OF US HAVE CHILDREN ON DOUBLE SESSION NOW? IF WE DO NOT GET ANOTHER SCHOOL SOON HOW MANY MORE CHILDREN WILL BE ON A DOUBLE SESSION NEXT YEAR? IT'S QUITE CONCEIVABLE THAT IF ACTION ISN'T TAKEN VERY SOON WE WILL HAVE DOUBLE SESSION ALL THE WAY TO SIXTH GRADE.

ON THE BRIGHTER SIDE IT WAS LEARNED AT OUR OCT. 19 MEETING THAT OUR PARK WILL BE STARTED A YEAR AHEAD OF SCHEDULE. THE PARK & RECREATION DEPT HAS TOLD US THAT \$50,000 IS AVAILABLE TO START CONSTRUCTION. TENTATIVE PLAN FOR THE FIRST PACKAGE INCLUDES CLEARING THE LAND, GRADING THE LAND, INSTALLATION OF A SPRINKLER SYSTEM,, CONSTRUCTION OF A SOFTBALL DIAMOND, AND LANDSCAPING.

WE WISH TO EXPRESS OUR THANKS TO DICK MILKOVICH FOR ATTENDING OUR MEETING AND EXPLAINING TO US THE TENTATIVE PLANS FOR THE PARK.

## 'S THE LAW



EXCERPTS FROM ORDINANCE NO. 258 PERTAINING TO ANIMALS.

SECTION 8. ANIMALS TRESPASSING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY. ANY ANIMAL OR FOWL FOUND TRESPASSING UPON ANY PRIVATE PROPERTY IN THE CITY MAY BE TAKEN UP BY AND PERSON AND COMMITTED TO THE CUSTODY OF THE MARSHAL; THE FEES PRESCRIBED HEREIN SHALL BE APPLICABLE AS IN OTHER CASES OF IMPOUNDING; AND IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR THE OWNER OR KEEPER, AFTER RECEIVING WRITTEN NOTICE THAT AN ANIMAL OR FOWL IS TRESPASSING UPON ANY PRIVATE PROPERTY, TO ALLOW SAID ANIMAL OR FOWL TO CONTINUE TO TRESPASS.

SECTION 39. UNLAWFUL TO ALLOW ANIMALS TO RUN AT LARGE. NO OWNER OR PERSON HAVING CONTROL OF ANY ANIMAL MENTIONED IN THIS ORDINANCE.....

AND OF LICENSED DOGS, SHALL PERMIT THE ANIMALS, OR ANY OF THEM NOT MENTIONED IN SAID EXCEPTION, TO RUN AT LARGE.....

ORDINANCE NO. 258  
ADOPTED: DECEMBER 2ND, 1946

## IT'S THE LAW



EXCERPTS FROM ORDINANCE NO. 41; GENERALLY CALLED A CURFEW ORDINANCE.

SEC. 1. IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 14 YEARS TO BE UPON ANY OF THE PUBLIC STREETS..., UNATTENDED BY ITS PARENTS OR GUARDIAN AFTER THE HOUR OF 8:30 PM, DURING THE MONTHS BEGINNING OCTOBER 1ST, AND ENDING APRIL 30TH OF EACH AND EVERY YEAR, AND AFTER THE HOUR OF 9 O'CLOCK P.M. DURING THE MONTHS BEGINNING MAY 1ST AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30TH, OF EACH YEAR.

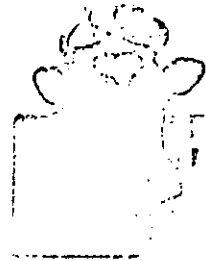

DEAR MEMBERS:

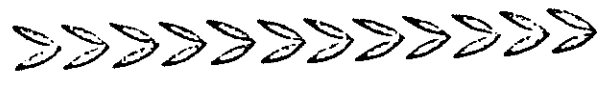
