DEAR EDITOR:

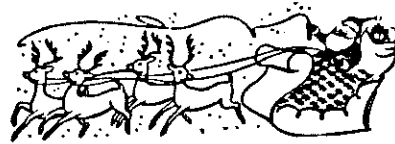
