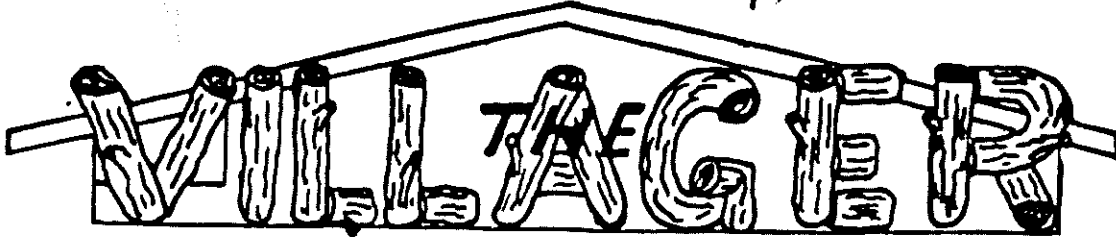

# L.V.R.A. MEETS JULY 6 7:30 P.M AT FAIRWOOD SCH

## EXECUTIVE BOARD REPORT

AT THE JUNE 1 LVRA MEETING, MR. CAL POOLE, FROM THE JUNIOR CHAMBER OF COMMERCE EXTENDED AN INVITATION TO US TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COMMUNITY FAIR TO BE HELD JULY 1-5 AT THE CHERRY CHASE SHOPPING CENTER. THE GENERAL MEMBERSHIP VOTED TO ACCEPT THE INVITATION AND PAY THE REQUIRED ENTRANCE FEE. MR. DON KITCHER WAS APPOINTED AS FAIR COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN

AS YOU HAVE PROBABLY READ AND HEARD, THE CITY COUNCIL HAS REJECTED HAVING THE AREA BETWEEN LAKEWOOD VILLAGE AND ORCHARD GARDENS ZONED RESIDENTIAL. THIS R-1 ZONING, WE FELT, WAS NEEDED AND BENEFICIAL TO BOTH AREAS. SINCE R-1 WAS DENIED US, WE FELT IT WAS TIME FOR THEM TO RECOGNIZE SOME OF OUR NEEDS AND DESIRES. A LETTER WAS WRITTEN TO THE CITY COUNCIL STATING THESE NEEDS. THIS LETTER ASKED FOR: THE LOWERING OF LAWRENCE STATION ROAD AND THE OPENING OF SANDIA, AN OVERWALK JOINING SANDIA AND LAKEHAVEN, A ROAD JOINING LAKEWOOD VILLAGE AND ORCHARD GARDENS, OPENING OF THE PLANNED PLAYGROUND EARLIER THAN THE PROPOSED DATE, LANDSCAPING OF FAIRWOOD SCHOOL, PICKING UP OF STRAY DOGS BY THE HUMANE SOCIETY, THE CITY TO BE STRICT IN REFUSING TO GRANT HOME INDUSTRY PERMITS, AND TO RESTRICT THE TYPE OF INDUSTRY TO BE PLACED NEAR HOMES. ALSO, A LETTER WAS WRITTEN TO THE HOMEOWNERS ADVISORY GROUP ASKING FOR A MEETING TO FIND OUT THE REASON FOR NOT BACKING US IN OUR DESIRE FOR RESIDENTIAL ZONING AS STATED ABOVE.

# IT'S THE LAW



FOLLOWING ARE EXCERPTS FROM "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ABATEMENT OF WEEDS IN THE CITY OF SUNNYVALE".

### SECTION 1. PUBLIC NUISANCE.

NO OWNER, AGENT, LESSEE OR OTHER PERSON OCCUPYING OR HAVING CHARGE OR CONTROL OF ANY BUILDING, LOT OR PREMISES WITHIN THE CITY SHALL PERMIT WEEDS TO REMAIN UPON SAID PREMISES, OR PUBLIC SIDEWALKS, OR STREETS, OR ALLEYS BETWEEN SAID PREMISES AND THE CENTER LINE OF ANY PUBLIC STREET OR ALLEY.

### SECTION 2. RESOLUTION DECLARING NUISANCE.

WHENEVER ANY SUCH WEEDS ARE GROWING UPON ANY PRIVATE PROPERTY OR PROPERTIES OR IN ANY STREET OR ALLEY WITHIN THE CITY, THE COUNCIL SHALL PASS A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE SAME TO BE A PUBLIC NUISANCE, AND ORDER THE CHIEF OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO GIVE NOTICE OF THE PASSAGE OF SUCH RESOLUTION AS HEREIN PROVIDED, AND STATING THEREIN THAT, UNLESS SUCH NUISANCE BE ABATED WITHOUT DELAY BY THE DESTRUCTION OR REMOVAL OF SUCH WEEDS, THE WORK OF ABATING SUCH NUISANCE WILL BE DONE BY THE CITY AUTHORITIES, AND THE EXPENSE THEREOF ASSESSED UPON THE LOTS AND LANDS FROM WHICH, AND/OR IN THE FRONT AND REAR OF WHICH, SUCH WEEDS SHALL HAVE BEEN DESTROYED OR REMOVED.

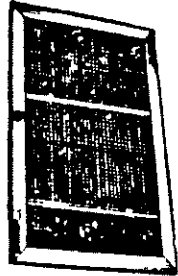
