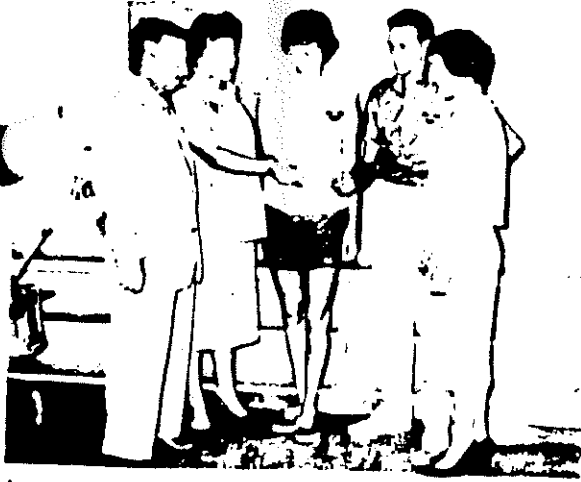

KEEP YOUR LAWN MOWER SHARP, AND MAKE SURE IT IS SET AT 1" HIGH. CUT YOUR LAWN REGULARLY IF YOU CAN, AND DON'T LET IT GET TOO TALL. ALWAYS USE YOUR GRASS CATCHER. LEAVING THE CLIPPINGS ON YOUR LAWN NOT ONLY LOOKS BAD, BUT IN A FEW YEARS WILL GIVE YOU LOTS OF TROUBLE.

LAWN'S SHOULD BE SPRAYED FOR WORMS 2 OR 3 TIMES A YEAR. IF THERE ARE WORMS IN YOUR LAWN, ALL THE FERTILIZER AND WATER YOU CAN PUT ON IT WON'T DO ANY GOOD.

USE A GOOD LIQUID FERTILIZER EVERY 4 TO 6 WEEKS DURING THE GROWING SEASON. THE REASON I RECOMMEND A LIQUID FERTILIZER IS BECAUSE YOU WON'T BURN OR DAMAGE YOUR LAWN AS EASILY.

IF KILLING THE WORMS AND FERTILIZING AND WATERING DOESN'T HELP YOUR LAWN, YOU PROBABLY HAVE FUNGUS, WHICH IS ONE OF THE WORSE LAWN MISERIES IN

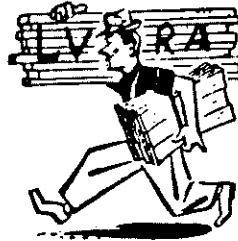

ARTICLE X STOPPING, STANDING, AND PARKING

10.5 USE OF STREETS FOR STORAGE OF
VEHICLES PROHIBITED. NO PERSON WHO
OWNS OR HAS POSSESSION, CUSTODY OR
CONTROL OF ANY VEHICLE SHALL PARK
SUCH VEHICLE UPON ANY STREET OR ALL-
BY FOR MORE THAN A CONSECUTIVE PER-
IOD OF 120 HOURS.

10.6 SAME. IN THE EVENT A VEHICLE IS
PARKED OR LEFT STANDING UPON A STREET
IN EXCESS OF A CONSECUTIVE PERIOD OF
120 HOURS, ANY PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER
AUTHORIZED BY THE CHIEF OF PUBLIC
SAFETY MAY REMOVE SAID VEHICLE FROM

THE STREET IN THE MANNER AND SUBJECT
TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE VEHICLE
CODE.

ORDINANCE NO. 589
ADOPTED: OCTOBER 8, 1957

EXCERPTS FROM ORDINANCE NO. 258 PER-
TAINING TO ANIMALS.

SECTION 8. ANIMALS TRESPASSING ON
PRIVATE PROPERTY. ANY ANIMAL OR FOWL
FOUND TRESPASSING UPON ANY PRIVATE
PROPERTY IN THE CITY MAY BE TAKEN UP
BY AND PERSON AND COMMITTED TO THE
CUSTODY OF THE MARSHAL; THE FEES PRE-
SCRIBED HEREIN SHALL BE APPLICABLE
AS IN OTHER CASES OF IMPOUNDING; AND
IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR THE OWNER
OR KEEPER, AFTER RECEIVING WRITTEN
NOTICE THAT AN ANIMAL OR FOWL IS
TRESPASSING UPON ANY PRIVATE PROPER-
TY, TO ALLOW SAID ANIMAL OR FOWL TO
CONTINUE TO TRESPASS.

SECTION 39. UNLAWFUL TO ALLOW ANI-
MALS TO RUN AT LARGE. NO OWNER OR
PERSON HAVING CONTROL OF ANY ANIMAL
MENTIONED IN THIS ORDINANCE.....,
AND OF LICENSED DOGS, SHALL PERMIT
THE ANIMALS, OR ANY OF THEM NOT MEN-
TIONED IN SAID EXCEPTION, TO RUN AT
