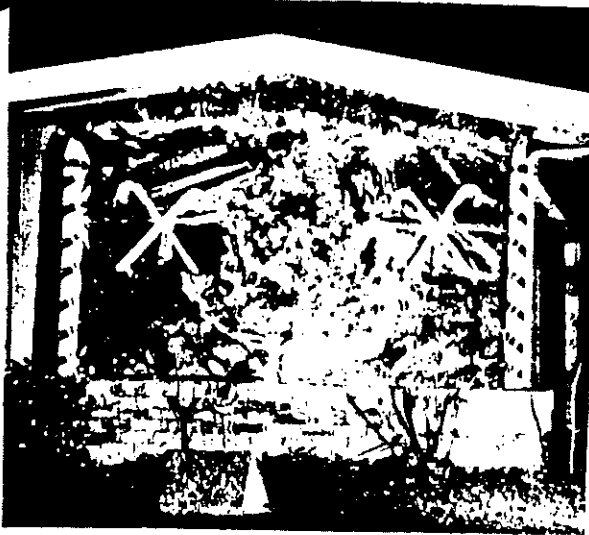

TEENS (CONT'D)

THE BEGINNING WAS IN AUG. 1958 WHEN A GROUP OF TEENAGERS MET FOR THE FIRST TIME IN THE MULTI-PURPOSE ROOM OF LAKEWOOD SCHOOL WITH SEVERAL INTERESTED ADULT MEMBERS OF THE LVRA. THEY DISCUSSED ACTIVITIES THE TEENAGERS WOULD LIKE AND WHAT COULD BE PROVIDED IF A CLUB WAS FORMED.

ANOTHER MEETING WAS HELD IN SEPT. FOR THE ELECTION OF TEMPORARY OFFICERS, & MORE SPECIFIC IDEAS. THUS A WEENIE ROAST AND FREE DANCE WERE GIVEN EARLY IN OCT. A LARGE MASQUERADE DANCE WAS HELD NOV. 1ST WITH PRIZES AND REFRESHMENTS. MEANWHILE WORK HAD ALREADY BEGUN FOR THE OFFICERS AND ADULT COUNSELORS WORKING CLOSELY WITH A RECREATION DEPT. SUPERVISOR TO FORM A CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS.

IN DEC. AN ELECTION BALL WAS HELD, THE CONSTITUTION WAS APPROVED, WITH COMES FOR EVERYONE, & OFFICERS WERE ELECTED. THE CONSTITUTION WAS PRESENTED TO THE SUNNYVALE COMMISSIONERS & THE LVRA EXECUTIVE BOARD BY THE OFFICERS. THE CLUB WAS SINCERELY APPROVED THUS MAKING IT BACKED PARTIALLY BY THE LVRA & CITY RECREATION DEPT. AFTER THAT TRIPS, CONTESTS, PARTIES, MOVIES, ACTIVITY NIGHTS, MONTHLY DANCES, BOWLING, AND MANY COMMUNITY PROJECTS.
