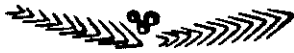

CHRISTMAS IS AN EXTRA SPECIAL TIME OF THE YEAR AND MOST OF US WOULD LIKE TO HAVE PLENTY OF SPECIAL FOODS ON HANDS FOR FRIENDS AND NEIGHBORS WHO DROP IN DURING THIS SEASON. YET, EACH YEAR PASSES WITH JUST THE MINIMUM OF BAKED GOODIES BECAUSE SOMEHOW OR OTHER THE TIME SLIPPED BY.

WHY NOT START THE HOLIDAY BAKING AND PLANNING NOW. PREPARE YOUR COOKIES, CAKES, PIES, ETC. NOW.... PERHAPS A BAKE FEST WITH YOUR NEIGHBORS WILL ADD IDEAS AND FUN TO YOUR PLANS.... PLACE GOODIES IN THE FREEZER TO BE BROUGHT WHEN NEEDED. THOSE YEAST ROLLS AND COFFEE CAKES MAY ALSO BE DONE AHEAD.

HERE'S A COOKIE RECIPE THAT EVEN THE JUNIOR COOK ABOUT THE HOUSE CAN MAKE WITH LITTLE EFFORT.

### SNOWDROPS:

- 1/3 CUP SHORTNING
- 1/3 CUP SIFTED, POWDERED SUGAR
- 1 CUP ALL PURPOSE FLOUR

- 1/4 TEASPOON SALT
  - 3 TABLESPOON EVAPORATED MILK
  - 1/2 TEASPOON VANILLA
  - 1/2 CUP FINELY CHOPPED NUTS
  - 2/3 CUP POWDERED SUGAR
- MIX SHORTENING AND 1/3 CUP POWDERED SUGAR IN BOWL UNTIL FLUFFY. ADD FLOUR, SALT, MILK, AND VANILLA. MIX UNTIL SMOOTH. STIR IN NUTS. ROLL TEASPOON OF DOUGH BETWEEN PALMS TO FORM A BALL. IF DOUGH SEEMS STICKY, LET CHILL FOR 15 MINUTES. PLACE BALLS 2 INCHES APART ON UN-GREASED COOKIE SHEET AND BAKE ON CENTER RACK OF OVEN ABOUT 30 MINUTES OR UNTIL VERY LIGHT BROWN. WHILE STILL WARM, ROLL IN 2/3 CUP OF POWDERED SUGAR. MAKES APPX. 2 1/2 DOZEN COOKIES.

## The Housewife

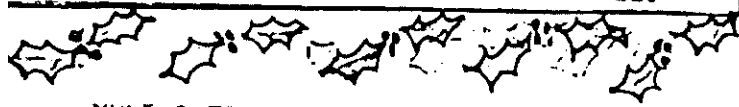

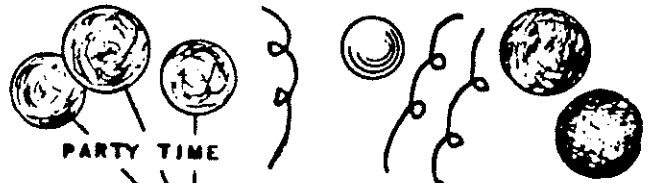

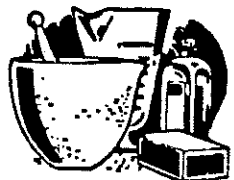
