HISTORY OF TROOP 425 B.S.A.

IN THIS OUR GOLDEN ANNIVERSARY YEAR WE WOULD LIKE TO RECOUNT OUR ACTIVITIES AND DOINGS OVER THE PAST TWO YEARS.

OUR TROOP STARTED WITH A BOY SAYING, "DAD, IF YOU DON'T HELP WE WON'T HAVE A TROOP." FIVE DADS ATTENDED THREE MEETINGS AT FREMONT HIGH SCHOOL TO ORGANIZE AND ALSO TO TAKE BASIC SCOUTERS TRAINING. THE THIRD WEEK WE SELECTED A COMMITTEE AND TWO LEADERS. ADRIAN F. HAVERMANN, SCOUTMASTER, RAY J. BARKER, ASS'T. SCOUTMASTER, MARVIN BOTTUM, CHAIRMAN AND ABE ELLIS, LARRY WHITAKER, BILL HAGGERTY, LANGHORN GEE AND FRANCIS SINGERBOX AS MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE. JOHN W. FORDHAM, SIXTH GRADE TEACHER, WAS APPOINTED AS INSTITUTIONAL REPRESENTATIVE. OUR TROOP IS SPONSORED BY THE FAIRWOOD SCHOOL P.T.A.

WE STARTED WITH ELEVEN BOYS IN DECEMBER, 1957. THE TROOP WAS NEW AND SO WERE MOST OF THE BOYS. THERE WAS ONE 1ST CLASS AND TEN CANDIDATE SCOUTS. ONLY TWO OF OUR LEADERS HAD BEEN IN SCOUTING BEFORE. ADE HAVERMANN, OUR SCOUTMASTER, HAD BEEN IN SCOUTING ABOUT SEVEN YEARS BEFORE THIS TIME. RAY BARKER ALSO HAD SEVERAL YEARS IN THE MOVEMENT.

OUR FIRST ACTIVITY WAS TO RAISE

MONEY FOR SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT. THE TASK WAS TO HAND OUT CIRCULARS ANNOUNCING A NEW BARBER SHOP OPENING IN SUNNYVALE. WE MADE \$16 FOR OUR FIRST ATTEMPT AND FELT REAL GOOD ABOUT IT. AFTER SEVERAL WEEKS OF TRAINING OUR TROOP, WE WENT ON A SHORT HIKE. THE TROOP HAD GROWN BY THEN TO 23 BOYS AND MR. HAVERMANN REALLY HAD HIS HANDS FULL. WE MADE UP PACKS TO SLING ON OUR BACKS AND HIKED TO THE DAIRY PROPERTY ON ALVISO ROAD. THAT DAY WE BUILT OUR FIRST FIRES AND LEARNED A LITTLE ABOUT AXE AND KNIFE SAFETY. WE ATE OUR LUNCH ALONG WITH THE STINK OF THE BAY. THEN WE WENT TO THE EDELWEISS DAIRY AND TOURED THE PLANT. THE OWNER SHOWED US HOW THE MILK IS RUN THROUGH THE PLANT AND TO THE BOTTLE. WE EVEN GOT FREE SAMPLES AND SOME CANDY.

DECEMBER 1957 WAS THE MONTH FOR OUR FIRST CEREMONY. MR. HAVERMANN INVESTED TEN CANDIDATE SCOUTS AS TENDERFOOT SCOUTS AND STARTED OUR CLIMB UP THE TRAIL OF SCOUTING. WE LIKE THE CEREMONIES BECAUSE IT GIVES US A CHANCE TO SHOW OFF TO OUR PARENTS AND FRIENDS, AND ALSO LETS US KNOW OUR EFFORTS ARE NOTICED.

FROM THE START WE HAVE BEEN A CAMPING TROOP, AND WE GO OUT IN THE WOODS AND HILLS EVERY MONTH. OUR FIRST CAMPOUT WAS AT CAMP STUART BOY SCOUT CAMP. THERE WERE 22 BOYS AND 8 DADS ALONG. FOR MANY OF US

IT WAS THE FIRST TIME IN THE WOODS OVERNIGHT AND IT WAS A LITTLE SCARY. WE HEARD ALL THE NIGHT ANIMALS AND SAW SIGNS OF THEM IN THE MORNING. WE WANDERED AROUND THE CAMP AND SAW ALL THE THINGS WE WOULD BE LEARNING ABOUT IN THE MONTHS TO FOLLOW. OUR CHOW WAS COOKED BY THE DADS 'CAUSE WE WOULD HAVE MADE A MESS OF IT. BOY, IT WAS REALLY GOOD EATING OUT IN THE FRESH AIR, ALONG WITH THE SMELL OF THE TREES AND STUFF. SINCE THEN, WE HAVE LEARNED TO COOK BY OURSELVES WITH THE HELP OF MR. HAVERMANN AND THE OTHER DADS, IT AIN'T BAD EITHER. ONE OF THE PATROLS, APACHES, CAN REALLY MAKE FRIED CHICKEN IN FOIL THAT'S ALMOST AS GOOD AS MOM MAKES. YOU SHOULD TASTE SOME OF THE FLAPJACKS THAT MR. HAVERMANN MAKES. HE EVEN MAKES HIS OWN SYRUP. THE TROOP GOES TO DIFFERENT AREAS TO CAMP. WE HAVE BEEN TO MT. MADONNA, BIG BASIN, SEARSVILLE LAKE, SUNNYVALE MOUNTAIN PARK, CRITES RANCH, CAMP HIGH SIERRA. AT HIGH SIERRA WE SPENT A WHOLE WEEK AND MAN WHAT FUN WE HAD.

AT THE END OF OUR FIRST YEAR WE REGISTERED 26 BOYS AND 9 DADS. BY THAT TIME THERE WERE ONE 1ST CLASS, EIGHT 2ND CLASS, AND SEVENTEEN TENDERFOOT SCOUTS.

SINCE WE STARTED WITH NO EQUIPMENT, WE HAD TO MAKE MONEY TO BUY TENTS AND STUFF FOR OUR CAMPING. THE MONEY CAME FROM BOTTLE DRIVES AND PAPER COLLECTIONS WHICH WE SOLD. THE MEN WENT OUT AND BOUGHT FIVE TENTS, AN AXE, TWO LANTERNS AND COOKING GEAR FOR EACH PATROL. OUR TENTS ARE KIND OF SMALL NOW AND WE ARE MAKING MONEY TO GET SOME MORE.

THE TROOP HAS WON MANY AWARDS IN THE PAST TWO YEARS, AMONG WHICH IS ONE THAT WE ARE REAL PROUD OF. THIS IS THE NATIONAL CAMPING AWARD THAT WE GOT AFTER OUR FIRST YEAR FOR HAVING FIFTY PERCENT OF THE GUYS WITH TEN DAYS AND NIGHTS OF CAMPING. THEN, TOO, THERE IS THE
