THESE ACTS ARE A DETRIMENT TO THE COMMUNITY. THEY LOWER ALL PROPERTY VALUES BY BLIGHTING THE APPEARANCE OF THE AREA, AND CAUSE EXPENSIVE PERSONAL DAMAGE TO MANY INDIVIDUALS LIVING HERE.

WE WONDER ABOUT THE PARENTS OF THESE CHILDREN. FOR THE CHILDREN'S OWN WELFARE AND FUTURE, THESE DESTRUCTIVE TENDENCIES MUST BE STOPPED.

### A CONFESSION

LET THEM GET OUT AND WORK FOR ME IF THEY WANT TO, BUT I'M NOT GOING TO BE A FOOL AND WORK FOR THEM. THIRDLY, HOW DID HE SAY THIS WAS GOING TO AFFECT MY HOME? WILL THOSE FOOLS DO SOMETHING TO RAISE MY TAXES? ARE THEY GOING TO TELL ME HOW TO RUN MY HOUSE? FOURTH, THEY ARE NOT! NO ONE'S GOING TO TELL ME WHAT TO DO AND HOW TO DO IT!

WELL, WITH HATRED IN OUR HEARTS AND SUSPICION GROWING, WE WENT TO THE MEETING. WE WEREN'T IMPRESSED ONE WAY OR THE OTHER. WE DIDN'T PARTICULARLY LIKE THE WAY IT WAS BEING HANDLED, BUT WE DIDN'T CARE VERY MUCH EITHER. THE ONLY REASON WE JOINED WAS TO INSURE US A VOICE IN CASE THEY DID SOMETHING WE DIDN'T LIKE.

LET ME STATE RIGHT NOW THAT I AM BASICALLY LAZY AND I INTENDED TO DO AS LITTLE AS POSSIBLE. WELL, THEY DID DO SOME THINGS WE DIDN'T LIKE SO WE GOT UP AND FOUGHT. WE

LET IT BE KNOWN WHAT WE DIDN'T LIKE AND WHY. IT WAS SURPRISING TO FIND OUT OTHER PEOPLE FELT THE SAME WAY.

WHEN ELECTIONS CAME AROUND, MY HUSBAND RAN FOR UNIT REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF KICKING THE OLD RASCALS OUT. HE HAD NO INTENTION OF WINNING, BUT IF HE DID, SOME THINGS WERE GOING TO BE CHANGED. HE WAS GOING TO FIND OUT WHAT COULD BE DONE FOR OUR HOME AND HOME VALUE AS WELL AS FOR OUR FAMILY. BY CHANCE HE WON. WE HAD TO LAUGH BECAUSE WE WEREN'T INTERESTED IN OTHER PEOPLE, JUST OURSELVES, AND HERE HE WAS REPRESENTING AND FIGHTING FOR OTHER PEOPLE.

SINCE THAT TIME WE HAVE FOUGHT JUST AS HARD FOR OUR RIGHTS AND INTERESTS. WE WERE WRONG ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS FOR WE FOUND OUT THE OTHER PEOPLE HAD NEEDS TO BE MET AND IDEAS THAT MUST BE EXPRESSED. WE ALSO FOUND OUT THAT YOU CAN ONLY HELP YOURSELF BY TRYING TO HELP OTHERS. I JOINED THE SOCIAL COMMITTEE AND FOUND OTHER WOMEN WHO ENJOYED DOING THINGS FOR OTHER PEOPLE AND WHO LIKED TO WORK. AS I HAVE SAID BEFORE, I DON'T LIKE TO WORK BUT THIS WAS FUN. WE WORKED TO FORM THE TEENAGERS, WE PLANNED DANCES, PARTIES AND PICNICS AND, BEST OF ALL, WE GOT TO KNOW OUR NEIGHBORS ALOT BETTER.

WE BOTH HOLD OFFICES IN THE L.V.R.A. AT THE PRESENT TIME. IT HAS BEEN ALOT OF FUN BUT I WILL
