

## "This is important .."

A REPUTABLE BUILDER WANTS APARTMENT ZONING AS A BUFFER BETWEEN HOMES ALONG PALAMOS, AND THE FACTORIES HE WILL BUILD IN AN INDUSTRIAL TRACT ON THE EAST SIDE OF LAWRENCE STATION RD.

THIS IS OF VITAL CONCERN TO RESIDENTS ALONG PALAMOS AVE. THEY KNOW THAT FACTORIES WILL LOWER THEIR HOME VALUES MORE THAN ONE STORY APARTMENTS AND DUPLEXES. ASK YOURSELF THESE QUESTIONS. WOULD YOU LIKE A FACTORY BEHIND YOUR BACKYARD? WOULD YOU PAY THE SAME PRICE FOR A HOME WITH INDUSTRY AS A NEIGHBOR? EIGHT OF THE FIFTY-FOUR HOMES VISITED, WERE VACANT WHEN WE POLLED THE RESIDENTS, BUT ONLY FOUR PEOPLE PREFERRED INDUSTRY. WE HAVE EIGHTY-THREE SIGNATURES ON A PETITION TO BE PRESENTED TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION, FAVORING DUPLEX AND SINGLE STORY APARTMENTS.



THE RESIDENTS OF LAKEBIRD AND GREENLAKE ARE EFFECTED ALSO; THEIR HOMES WILL BE NEXT. THEIR FIGHT IS YOUR FIGHT, TOO. MORE PEOPLE IN LAKEWOOD VILLAGE WOULD MEAN A BETTER AND MORE COMPLETE SHOPPING CENTER, AND CALL FOR MORE SCHOOLS, OUR PARK COMPLETED SOONER, AND A PEDESTRIAN OVER-CROSSING AT PALAMOS. INCIDENTLY, SCHOOLS ARE BUILT ON A RESIDENCE BASIS, SO APARTMENTS WOULD HELP OUR SCHOOL PROBLEM, SINCE APARTMENTS HAVE FEW CHILDREN PER UNIT.

YOUR HOME VALUE, (NOT ONLY THE PRICE YOU COULD GET, SHOULD YOU SELL, BUT ITS VALUE TO YOU) IS GREATLY DETERMINED BY ITS LOCATION. (I.E., WILL LAKEWOOD VILLAGE BE CONSIDERED A GOOD RESIDENTIAL AREA OR A POOR ONE, IN PEOPLES ESTIMATION? IF FACTORIES ARE BUILT UP TO OUR BACKYARDS, CUT OFF AS WE ARE BY BAYSHORE, WE WILL ALL LOSE.

BECAUSE IT IS GOOD CITY PLANNING TO HAVE A BUFFER BETWEEN INDUSTRY AND RESIDENTIAL AREAS, IS NO GUARANTEE THAT THE CITY COUNCIL WILL APPROVE THIS ZONING. THE COUNCIL HAS, IN THE PAST, DISREGARDED THE WISHES AND BEST INTERESTS OF NEARBY RESIDENTS. YOU MAY BE CALLED UPON TO SIGN A PETITION, AND SHOULD BE PRESENT AT THE PLANNING COMMISSION AND CITY COUNCIL, WHEN THE ISSUE IS PRESENTED FOR DISCUSSION.

LANDSCAPING IS IN THE PROCESS OF COMPLETION WITH TURFING GOING IN AT FAIRWOOD SCHOOL; A BIG HELP TO THE APPEARANCE OF LAKEWOOD VILLAGE. LATEST PLANS HAVE LAKEWOOD & FAIRWOOD SCHEDULED FOR FOUR DOUBLE-SESSIONS, WITH NEW CLASSROOMS PUT OFF UNTIL 1961, DUE TO THE CUT IN THE STATE BUDGET. THE SITUATION MAY BE EASED BY SENDING SOME ORCHARD GARDENS PUPILS TO OTHER SCHOOLS ACROSS BAYSHORE.

#### SIGNALS, CONT.

RALLY LOCATED." THE LAKEBIRD-PALAMOS SIGNALS WILL GO IN AT SOME INDEFINITE TIME. THEY DOUBTED THAT THE STATE DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS WOULD APPROVE OF A SIGNAL AT LAKEWOOD DRIVE, BRIDGEWOOD WAY, BECAUSE OF THE DETRIMENTAL EFFECTS TO FREEWAY OPERATION.

WHEN THE CITY WILL LOWER LAWRENCE STATION ROAD AND INSTALL ONE SIGNAL, WILL DEPEND UPON WHEN THE BAYSHORE INTERSECTION IS BUILT - PROBABLY ONE AND A HALF YEARS FROM NOW. STREET LIGHTS ARE PLANNED TO BE ERECTED IN THE CENTER DIVIDING STRIP AT THE SAME TIME. IMPROVEMENTS OF LAWRENCE STATION ROAD TO EXPRESSWAY STANDARDS WAITS FOR THE CITIES AND COUNTY TO GET TO-GETHER ON THE COUNTY EXPRESSWAY SYSTEM.

BOTH OFFICIALS WERE STRONG IN THEIR OPINION THAT NO CROSS-WALKS SHOULD BE PAINTED UNTIL THE SIGNAL IS IN, AND ONLY AT THE SIGNAL CROSSING. THEY FEARED THAT RESIDENTS WOULD DRAW THE NORMAL CONCLUSION THAT BECAUSE CROSS-WALKS WERE IN, IT WAS SAFE TO CROSS, AND LET THEIR CHILDREN CROSS, WHEN SUCH WAS NOT THE CASE. LAWRENCE STATION IS NOW A 65 MPH EXPRESSWAY, BUT THE CITY IS NOW WORKING ON REDUCTION OF THE SPEED LIMIT.

THEY REALIZE THE UNDESIRABILITY OF ISOLATING ONE AREA IN A PLANNED COMMUNITY, WITH AN EXPRESSWAY, AND SUGGEST THE POSSIBILITY OF A PEDESTRIAN OVERCROSSING THAT WOULD COST \$25,000 OR \$30,000. SUGGESTED ALSO, WAS THAT OTHER POSSIBILITIES MIGHT BE APPARENT AFTER THE STATE COMPLETES ITS INTERCHANGE.

THE LETTER WILL BE READ AT OUR NEXT MEETING, AND ANY QUESTIONS YOU MIGHT HAVE, WILL BE ASKED OF THE CITY BY YOUR ASSOCIATION.
