DESPITE THE BEST EFFORTS OF THE L.V.R.A. BOARD, AND THE VILLAGER TO STIR UP SOME INTEREST AMONG THE RESIDENTS, THE MEETINGS CONTINUE TO BE VERY LIGHTLY ATTENDED- DISCOURAGINGLY SO. IT'S UNBELIEVABLE THAT IN A SUBDIVISION OF 1600 HOMES, SO FEW PEOPLE ARE INTERESTED IN LOCAL AND COUNTY ISSUES, WHICH EFFECT ALL OF US SO DIRECTLY.

IF YOU WERE FACED WITH A LAWSUIT, YOU WOULD GLADLY PAY A LAWYER'S FEE TO DEFEND YOU, AND YOU MOST LIKELY PAY INSURANCE ON YOUR VALUABLES... DOESN'T IT SEEM ONLY LOGICAL THEN, TO JOIN AN ASSOCIATION FORMED FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF PROTECTING YOUR MOST EXPENSIVE INVESTMENT - YOUR HOME? ISN'T YOUR HOME WELL WORTH A SMALL AMOUNT OF YOUR TIME, AND THE TINY DUES OF \$2 A YEAR? YOUR ASSOCIATION WAS PRESENT WHEN THE PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMENDED A "BUFFER ZONE" OF APARTMENTS BEHIND THE PALAMOS AVENUE HOMES, TO THE CITY COUNCIL.

THIS WAS A MAJOR STEP TOWARDS MAINTAINING AND IMPROVING LAKEWOOD VILLAGE AS A GOOD RESIDENTIAL AREA. NEXT, THE COUNCIL WILL GIVE THEIR INFORMAL DIS-APPROVAL OR APPROVAL TO THE PLAN. IN DUE TIME, THE REGULAR PROCEDURE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS WILL TAKE PLACE. PARTICULARLY AT THESE PUBLIC HEARINGS, YOUR PARTICIPATION IS NEEDED.

WE WANT TO EMPHASIZE THAT WE ARE BACKING SINGLE-STORY MULTIPLE DWELLINGS, NOT TWO STORY APARTMENTS!! THOUGH TWO STORY APARTMENTS ARE PREFERABLE TO FACTORIES, THE PRIVACY OF THE PALAMOS RESIDENTS MUST BE PROTECTED. 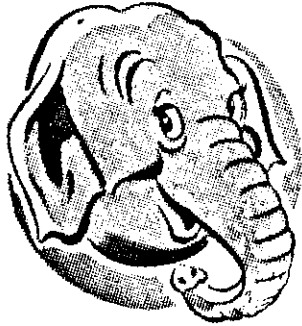




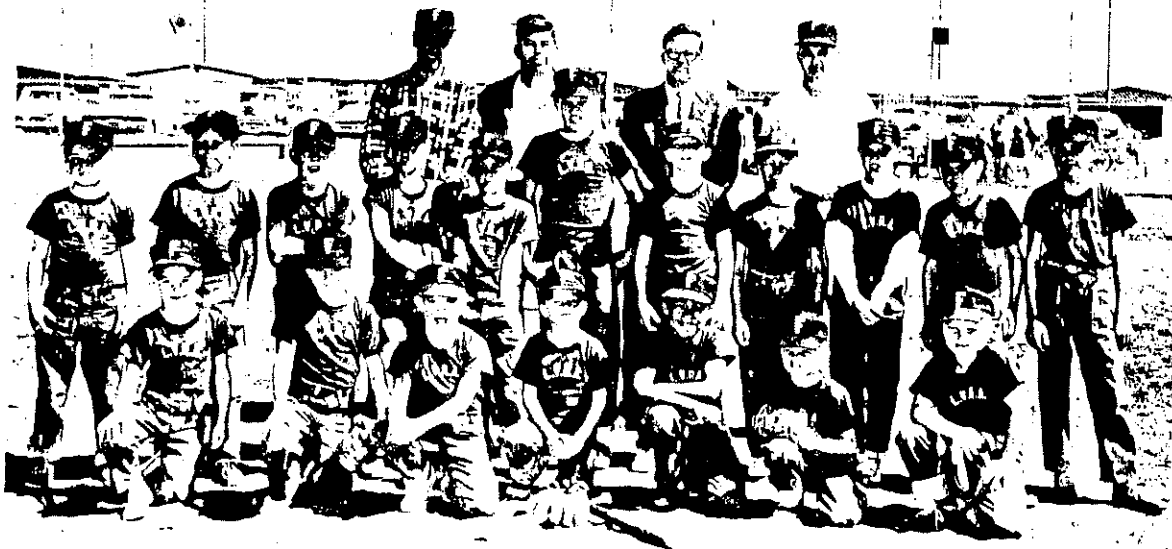
