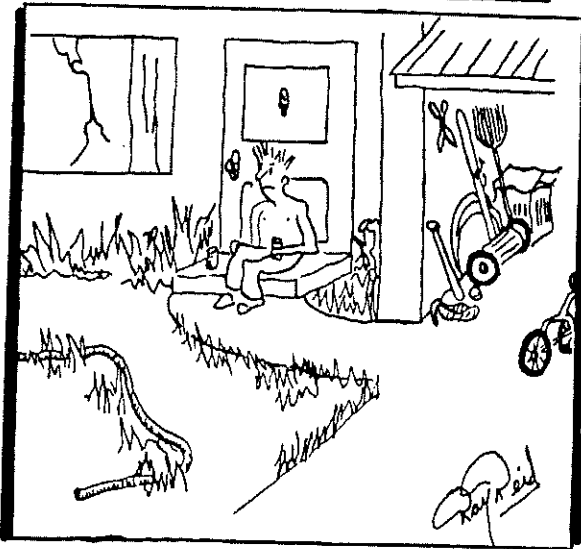

NOTES FROM THE BOARD



AT OUR LAST MEETING, MR. ALEXANDER JAMA AND MR. SIDNEY MITCHELL, THE INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPERS, PRESENTED THE REASONS WHY APARTMENTS ARE BEST BEHIND THE PALAMOS AVENUE HOMES. THOSE PRESENT, VOTED UNANIMOUSLY TO FAVOR TWO-STORY APARTMENTS OVER FACTORIES, AS OUR SECOND CHOICE. OUR PREFERENCE IS SINGLE-STORY APARTMENTS ADJACENT TO THE HOMES.

THE INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPER NEEDS A BUFFER ZONE, BECAUSE INDUSTRY WANTS ONE. APARTMENT BUILDERS WANT TO BUILD THERE, AND CLAIM THERE IS A DEMAND IN THE LOCATION. THE SHOPPING CENTER OWNERS AND OPERATORS NEED THE ADDITIONAL BUSINESS, WANT TO RENT THE VACANT SHOPS, AND ADD A MEDICAL CENTER. RESIDENTS OF PALAMOS AND THE REST OF LAKEWOOD VILLAGE, NEED THIS BUFFER TO PRESERVE THE RESIDENTIAL CHARACTER

OF THE AREA, AND FOR MANY OTHER REASONS. IT IS EXCELLANT CITY PLANNING, AS WELL.

BUT, THERE IS ONE REASON WHY WE MAY NOT GET THIS ZONING...THE CITY COUNCIL AND CITY ADMINISTRATORS ARE VERY RELUCTANT TO GIVE UP ANY INDUSTRIAL LAND. THIS IS UNDERSTANDABLE; INDUSTRY PROVIDES MONEY AND RESIDENTS COST THE CITY FOR SERVICES. THE MORE INDUSTRY A CITY HAS, THE LOWER THE TAXES. THOUGH WE BELIEVE THAT RIGHT IS ON OUR SIDE, AND THAT A BUFFER ZONE IS BEST FOR EVERYONE IN SUNNYVALE THE CITY COUNCIL WILL SET THE ZONING AS IT SEES FIT.

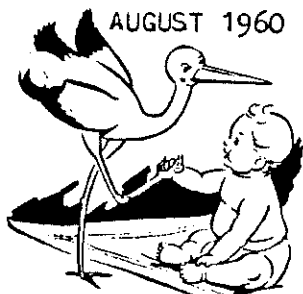
NAME THE NEW VILLAGE SCHOOL

IT'S THE LAW



DISTURBING THE PEACE. No person shall disturb the peace, quiet and comfort of the community or any neighborhood therein by creating therein any unreasonably loud or disturbing or unnecessary noises.

The following noises, among others, are hereby declared to be disturbing the peace, quiet and comfort of the community or neighborhood wherein they are created, and in violation of the preceding section; provided, however, that such enumeration shall not be deemed or construed as in any degree exclusive, but merely illustrative, it being the intent and purpose of this article to include and prohibit all noises of the kind described in the preceding section.

A. The sounding of any horn, signal, or noise device on any automobile, motorcycle, bus, truck, or other vehicle, in any other manner or for any other purpose than required by the vehicle code, or other laws of the state; and the exhaust system of all such vehicles shall be equipped or constructed as to prevent any unreasonably loud, disturbing or unnecessary noise.

B. Racing the engine of any vehicle, (while such vehicle is not in motion) except when necessary to do so in the course of repairing, adjusting or testing same.

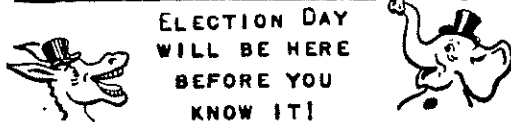

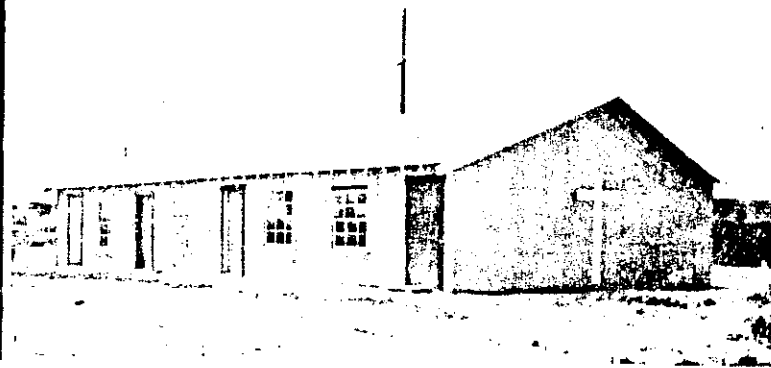
