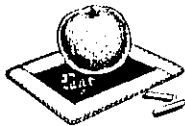
Back-to-School

THE SUNNYVALE SCHOOL DISTRICT'S \$2,000,000. BOND PROPOSAL IS OF VITAL INTEREST TO ALL RESIDENTS OF SUNNYVALE. IT'S PURPOSE IS TO CONTINUE CONSTRUCTION OF NEEDED

SCHOOLS IN THE CITY, UNDER THE STATE AID PROGRAM. UNLESS A SCHOOL DISTRICT IS BONDED TO CAPACITY, (5% OF THE VALUATION OF THE DISTRICT) IT IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO BORROW STATE BUILDING FUNDS.

IF THIS BOND ISSUE IS PASSED, IT WILL DIRECTLY BENEFIT LAKEWOOD VILLAGE, BY MAKING POSSIBLE THE NEW SCHOOL ON THE TENTATIVE SITE AT LAKEBIRD & HIDDENLAKE DRIVE, AS WELL AS PROVIDING ADDITIONAL CLASSROOMS AT LAKEWOOD SCHOOL.
