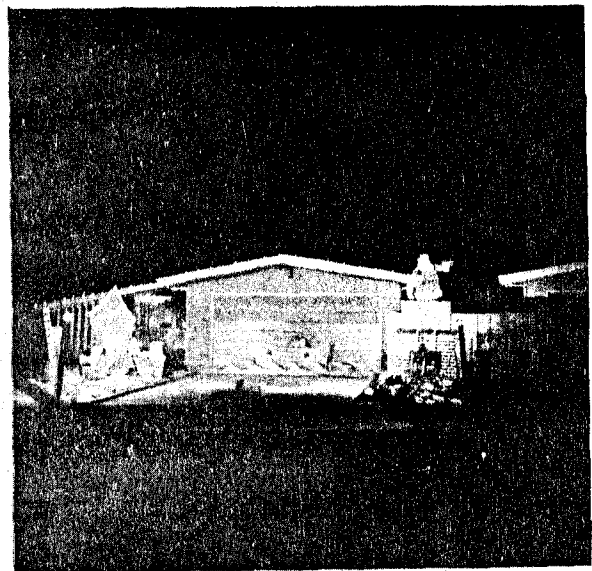




HALVERSON'S COP FIRST PLACE IN YULE LIGHTING CONTEST

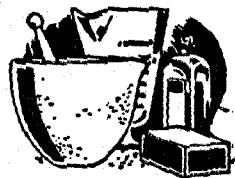

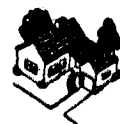
