PART 1 A BRIEF HISTORY



IN THE EARLY DAYS, TRAVELERS PASSED THROUGH THE SUNNYVALE AREA ON THE KING'S HIGHWAY, IE EL CAMINO REAL. SETTLERS LOCATED ON LANDS RECEIVING TITLE THROUGH SPANISH LAND GRANTS, AND IN ORDER TO ATTEND SCHOOL OR CHURCH, THEY HAD TO TRAVEL TO SAN JOSE, THE MISSION SANTA CLARA OR SAN FRANCISCO.

IN 1865, MARTIN MURPHY JR. PURCHASED A TRACT OF LAND FROM RANCHO PASTORIA DE LAS BORREGAS (SHEPHERDS OF THE LAMBS). THE MURPHY HOUSE, TO BE RAZED SHORTLY, WAS FRAMED IN BOSTON AND SHIPPED AROUND THE HORN WHEN THE MURPHYS SETTLED HERE IN 1849.

IN THE 1860'S WHEN A RAILROAD STATION WAS BUILT NEARBY, THE TOWN OF "MURPHY STATION" CAME INTO BEING. INDUSTRIES, BUSINESSES, SCHOOLS, CLUBS, AND CHURCHES FORMED THE NUCLEUS OF THE COMMUNITY, AND THE CENTER OF ACTIVITIES SHIFTED FROM THE MANY OUT-LYING HOMESTEADS TO THE CENTRAL DOWNTOWN.

ON DECEMBER 24, 1912, THE TOWN WAS INCORPORATED AS A 6TH CLASS CITY. THE TOWN HAD BEEN KNOWN FOR A TIME AS ENCINAL, BUT

THAT NAME WAS DROPPED WHEN IT BECAME KNOWN THAT ANOTHER CITY HAD ALREADY ADOPTED THAT NAME.

UNTIL 1940, AT WHICH TIME IT HAD A POPULATION OF 4,373, THE CITY'S ACTIVITIES WERE SITUATED WITHIN A QUARTER MILE RADIUS. AFTER THAT, NEW COMMERCIAL CENTERS, BOTH REGIONAL (CHERRY CHASE) AND NEIGHBORHOOD (LAKEWOOD) ENDED THE SINGLE CENTER CITY, AND SUNNYVALE BECAME A METROPOLITAN SUB-CENTER, A PART OF THE METROPOLITAN REGION SURROUNDING THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY.
