THESE ARE THE CHANGES IN BY-LAWS RECOMMENDED BY THE EXECUTIVE BOARD AND BY-LAWS COMMITTEE THAT YOU WILL BE ASKED TO VOTE ON AT THE NOVEMBER 15 MEETING.

#### ARTICLE 111 - GOVERMENT:

A. (BEGINNING WITH SECOND SENTENCE.)  
THE EXECUTIVE BOARD SHALL CONSIST OF THE VICE-PRESIDENT, SECRETARY, TREASURER, PLAYER-AGENT, SENIOR DIVISION DIRECTOR AND ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM BOTH THE MAJOR AND MINOR DIVISIONS. THE DIVISION DIRECTORS WILL BE APPOINTED BY THE ELECTED OFFICERS.

B. AT THE ANNUAL MEETING IN SEPT., THE MEMBERS SHALL ELECT THEIR OFFICERS. OFFICERS SHALL SERVE FOR A TERM OF ONE YEAR. NO OFFICER SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO THE SAME OFFICE FOR MORE THAN TWO CONSECUTIVE TERMS. OFFICERS SHALL ASSUME THEIR OUTIES AT THE END OF THE SEPTEMBER MEETING.

D. (BEGINNING WITH SECOND SENTENCE.)  
STANDING COMMITTEES WILL INCLUDE SPONSOR CONTACT, PUBLICITY, WAYS AND MEANS AND EQUIPMENT.

E. VACANCIES IN OFFICE SHALL BE FILLED BY THE EXECUTIVE BOARD.

F. THE ELECTED OFFICERS SHALL NOT SIMULTANEOUSLY MANAGE OR COACH A COMPETITIVE TEAM.

#### ARTICLE IV - MEETINGS:

B. FIVE MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD SHALL CONSTITUTE A QUORUM AT ANY MEETING AND THE MAJORITY VOTE OF THOSE PRESENT SHALL GOVERN.

D. MEETINGS OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD WILL BE HELD MONTHLY ON THE 2ND WED. OF EACH MONTH.

#### ARTOC:E VII - FINANCIAL POLICY:

C. THE TREASURER SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL FUNDS OF THE LEAGUE AND SHALL PAY OUT SUMS ONLY ON ORDER OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD. IN THE ABSENCE OF THE TREASURER, THE PRESIDENT SHALL BE AUTHORIZED TO SIGN CHECKS ON BEHALF OF THE LEAGUE.

D. THE PRESIDENT SHALL AUTHORIZE THE TREASURER TO PAY INCIDENTAL EXPENSES OF THE ORGANIZATION UP TO \$25.00 PER MONTH, WITHOUT ORDER OF THE EXECU-

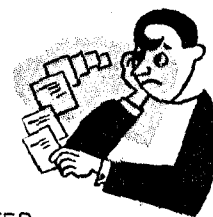

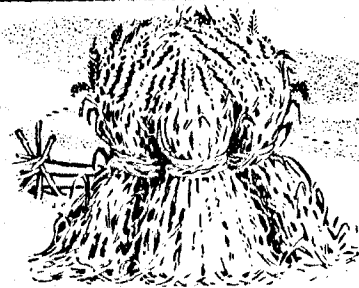


### Household Hints!

#### HINTS FOR REMOVING STAINS:

- FOR CHEWING GUM:** If the material will not water spot, rub the gum stain with ice. Then scrape and rub the hardened gum out of the cloth. This method is particularly good for rugs and other heavy materials.
- FRUITS AND BERRIES:**

Treat fruit and berry stains immediately, if possible. They are hard to remove after they are dry. Boiling water (if it does not harm the cloth) or sometimes even warm water will remove most fruit stains.

GEORGE E. MARTIN, DVM, PUBLIC HEALTH VETERINARIAN, WARNS PERSONS NOT TO PICK UP OR HANDLE SICK OR STRANGELY BEHAVING BATS. A BUTTE COUNTY WOMAN IN 1958 DIED FOLLOWING A BITE RECEIVED WHEN SHE PICKED UP A BAT THAT WAS LYING ON THE GROUND NEAR THE PORCH OF HER HOME. ANY PERSON BITTEN BY A BAT SHOULD VISIT A PHYSICIAN FOR ANTI-RABIES TREATMENT.

FREQUENTLY DOGS COME IN CONTACT WITH BATS, AS WELL AS SKUNKS, FOXES AND OTHER SOURCES OF RABIES, CONTINUED DR. MARTIN, MAKING IT NECESSARY TO VACCINATE ALL DOGS AGAINST RABIES IN ORDER TO PROTECT BOTH THE DOG AND THE HUMAN POPULATIONS.

DOY OWNERS WHOSE ANIMALS ARE NOT VACCINATED SHOULD AVAIL THEMSELVES OF THE SERVICES OF THEIR PRIVATE VETERINARIAN OR HEALTH DEPARTMENT CLINICS.

BY ORDINANCE ALL DOGS MUST BE VACCINATED AGAINST RABIES AND LICENSED.

(SOME OF THESE RULES ARE FOR GIRLS, BUT BOYS SHOULD KNOW THEM, TOO, IN ORDER TO PROTECT SISTERS OR GIRLFRIENDS.)



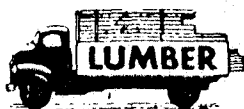
