

LAKEWOOD LIGHTING CONTEST

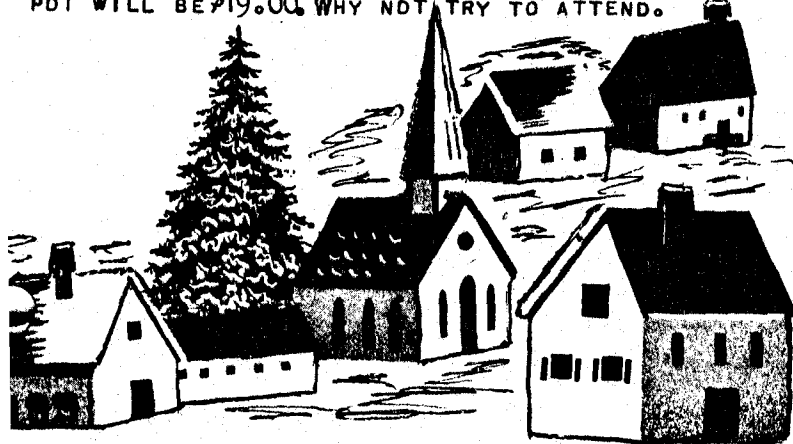

 IS LITTLE LEAGUE BASEBALL IN YOUR HOME
 COMMUNITY WORTH A LITTLE OF YOUR TIME?

THE MEETING OF NOV. 15TH. SHOWED A TOTAL OF 22 PEOPLE (SOME WERE WITH THEIR HUSBANDS) ATTENDING. THIS JUST DOESN'T COVER A PERCENTAGE OF POPULATION NECESSARY TO HOLD A FRANCHISE IN LAKEWOOD VILLAGE!

HAVE THE PARENTS OF LAKEWOOD VILLAGE COST THEIR SONS LITTLE LEAGUE?

THIS SEEMS AN UNUSUAL QUESTION TO ASK ABOUT FATHERS IN A COMMUNITY WHOSE VERY ESSENCE IS YOUTH, VITALITY AND PROGRESS. AND ESPECIALLY, IN AN AREA DEVOTED TO THE WELL BEING OF THEIR SONS.

HOW MANY FATHERS PLAYED SAND-LOT BASEBALL WHEN THEY WERE KIDS? I DID.

DID ANY DREAM OF UNIFORMS, AN AUDIENCE THAT CHEERED--AND MAYBE HITTING THE LONGEST HOME RUN IN THE WORLD? OR MAKING A ONE HANDED CATCH "LIKE DIMAGGIO"--RIGHT IN FRONT OF THEIR FATHER? I DID.

WHO DREAMED OF STANDING ON THE MOUND, EYEING THE FILLED BASES LIKE A HAWK, WINDING UP, AND THROWING? "STUH-RIKE THREE-- --AND, YOU'RE OUT!!" YOU'VE HELPED WIN ANOTHER GAME. I DID.

I DREAMED AND WAITED AND HOPED AND GOT OLDER AND MOST OF THESE DREAMS BECAME TARNISHED WITH TIME. AND THEN, IT WAS TOO LATE.

THE UNIFORM WITH THE "JUST RIGHT" CAP, THE ONE HAND CATCH THAT SAVED MY TEAM AND MY DOUBLE PLAY WERE JUST MEMORIES OF DREAMS, AND I'D NEVER HELPED A TEAM WIN A GAME-- AT ALL.

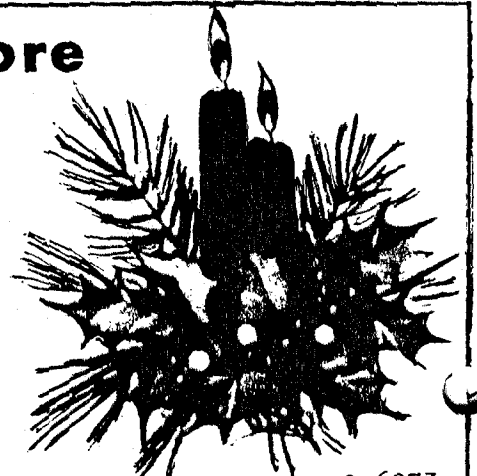

 CAN ENJOY PLAYING AMERICA'S NATIONAL SPORT. SUCH RULES AS "EVERY PLAYER IS GUARENTEED AT LEAST TWO INNINGS PER WEEK, REGARDLESS OF PLAYING ABILITY" IS ONE EXAMPLE OF THE INTENT OF LITTLE LEAGUE. IT WOULD APPEAR THEN, THAT IT IS NOT SO MUCH A TRAINING GROUND FOR BASEBALL AND IT'S RULES AS IT IS FOR HELPING YOUR SON LEARN FAIR-PLAY, SPORTSMANSHIP AND SELF DISCIPLINE.

MAJOR REQUIREMENTS FOR A LEAGUE FRANCHISE ARE BOYS, SPACE, EQUIPMENT, INTEREST, AND PARENT PARTICIPATION.

SPACE IS AVAILABLE. THERE IS QUITE A BIT OF EQUIPMENT. ONE LOOK AROUND (CHECK IN FRONT OF THE T.V.) SHOWS THERE IS NO SHORT-AGE OF BOYS--AND BELIEVE ME, THEY FURNISH THE INTEREST. AND, THIS LEAVES JUST ONE VITAL PART MISSING--PARENTS!

THIS COULD HAVE BEEN AN INDICATION THAT PARENTS WERE WILLING TO SEE IT GO TO A COMMUNITY WITH A DIFFERENT ATTITUDE; A HIGHER RATIO OF PARENT INTEREST. MAYBE PARENTS DO NOT WANT LITTLE LEAGUE TO STAY IN LAKEWOOD FOR THEIR SONS. BUT, IT COULD MEAN THAT NO ONE HAD NOTIFIED THEM OF THE THREAT TO THEIR RIGHTS--PLACED IN TRUST WITH THEM, FOR THEIR SONS. BUT, THEY ARE YOUR SONS AND YOU SHOULD HAVE THE RIGHT TO SAY WHETHER OR NOT THERE IS LITTLE LEAGUE IN LAKEWOOD VILLAGE.

ANOTHER MEETING IS SCHEDULED SO THAT ANOTHER, MORE VALID, INDEX OF PARENT INTEREST IN LITTLE LEAGUE MAY BE MADE. IT WILL BE AT MULTI-PURPOSE ROOM, FAIRWOOD SCHOOL 8:00 P.M., DECEMBER 5, 1961. YOUR PRESENCE THERE CAN MEAN THE DIFFERENCE IN WHETHER OR NOT THERE IS LITTLE LEAGUE IN LAKEWOOD NEXT SUMMER. IT'S UP TO YOU.
