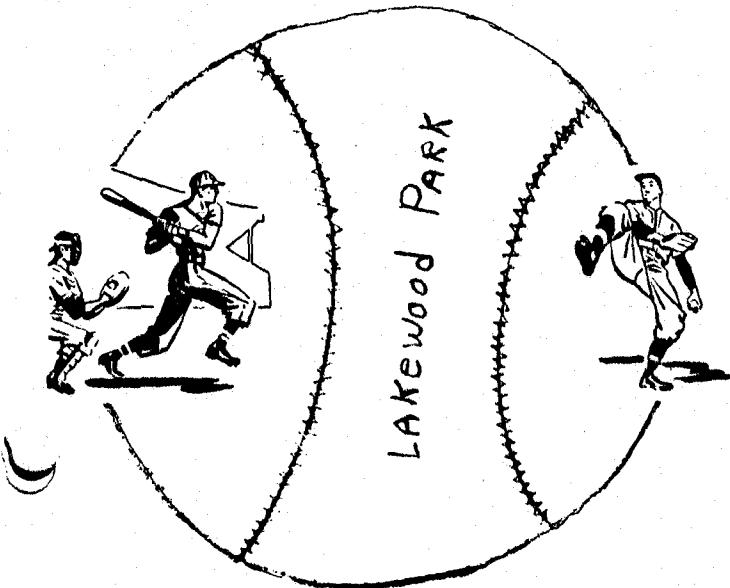


PARK AND RECREATION DIRECTOR TO MEET WITH L V R A

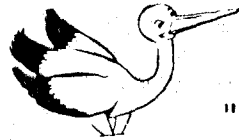

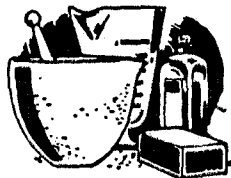
