RECENTLY A NEW BIKE SAFETY LAW WENT INTO EFFECT AND IT IS HOPED THAT THE PARENTS OF EVERY YOUNSTER THAT OWNS AND RIDES A BICYCLE HAS READ THESE NEW LAWS TO THEM AND THE KIDS ARE OBEYING THEM.

ALL BIKES SHOULD HAVE A LICENSE AND ONE MAY BE OBTAINED FOR A \$1.00. IT'S GOOD FOR LIFE PROVIDING THE RULES ARE OBSERVED FOR FLAUNTING THE RULES COULD EASILY MEAN A REVOKED OR CANCELED LICENSE. TOO, A LICENSE WILL BE ISSUED ONLY TO BIKES THAT PASS A MECHANICAL INSPECTION.

RULES OF THE ROAD NOW REQUIRE A WHITE LIGHT IN FRONT AND RED REFLECTOR IN BACK OF THE BIKE. GOOD BRAKES ARE A MUST. TWO MAY NOT RIDE AT THE SAME TIME ON THE SAME BIKE. SIDEWALK RIDING AROUND SCHOOLS OR COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS IS FORBIDDEN. PARKING IS ALLOWED ON SIDEWALKS ONLY IF IT DOESN'T OBSTRUCT PEDESTRIANS.

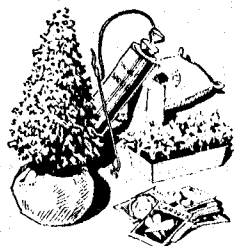
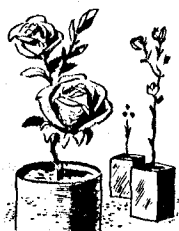

"SHRIMPBURGERS"

- 1 (12 OUNCE) PACKAGE FROZEN COOKED SHRIMP
- 3 TABLESPOONS BUTTER OR MARGARINE
- 3 TABLESPOONS FLOUR
- 3/4 CUP MILK
- 1 CUP COOKED RICE
- 3/4 CUP GRATED PROCESS CHEESE
- 2 TABLESPOONS GRATED ONION
- 1 TEASPOON SALT
- 1/8 TEASPOON PEPPER AND DASH OF CAYENNE
- 1/2 TEASPOON CURRY POWDER

LET SHRIMP THAW. RESERVE SIX WHOLE SHRIMP FOR GARNISHING. CUT REST OF SHRIMP INTO SMALL PIECES. MELT BUTTER, REMOVE FROM HEAT AND STIR IN FLOUR. RETURN TO HEAT AND GRADUALLY ADD THE MILK, STIRRING CONSTANTLY UNTIL THICK. COMBINE WITH REMAINING INGREDIENTS. IF POSSIBLE CHILL FOR EASY HANDLING. SHAPE INTO PATYIES. ROLL SHRIMPBURGERS IN FINE DRY BREADCRUMBS. FRY IN ABOUT 1/2 INCH OF HOT FAT IN A SKILLET UNTIL BROWNE ON ONE SIDE, ABOUT 2 MINUTES. TURN AND BROWN OTHER SIDE. SERVE ON TOASTED HAMBURGER BUNS WITH RELISH OR CHUTNEY. GARNISH WITH WHOLE SHRIMP AND SERVE. SERVES 6.
