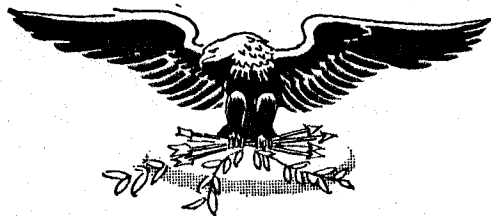
TIME PLACE

SUNDAY JUNE 25 AT 1 0'CLOCK
WASHINGTON PARK, SUNNYVALE
WASHINGTON AVE. & PASTORIA

IT WAS NOT UNTIL JUNE 14, 1777, ALMOST A YEAR AFTER THE ADOPTION OF THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE, THAT THE CONTINENTAL CONGRESS ADOPTED A DESIGN FOR THE NATIONAL FLAG.

IT RESOLVED THAT "THE FLAG OF THE UNITED STATES SHALL BE THIRTEEN STRIPES, ALTERNATE RED AND WHITE WITH A UNION OF THIRTEEN STARS FIVE POINTED WHITE ON A BLUE FIELD, REPRESENTING A NEW CONSTELLATION". A COMPARISON OF THIS DESIGN WITH THAT OF THE CONTINENTAL FLAG SHOWS THAT THE ONLY CHANGE WAS A UNION OF STARS TO REPLACE THE UNION OF THE CROSSES OF ENGLAND AND SCOTLAND, USING THE SAME BLUE FIELD.

HENCE THE STARS AND STRIPES EVOLVED IN TWO STAGES FROM THE BRITISH RED ENSIGN.

IN VIEW OF THE LETTER PUBLISHED LAST MONTH IN THE "VILLAGER" WRITTEN BY A MOTHER WHOSE CHILD HAD A TREASURED TOY TAKEN FROM HIM BY AN OLDER OR BIGGER BOY ON HIS WAY HOME FROM SCHOOL AND THE ADDED FOOT NOTE AND I QUOTE "THIS ISN'T THE ONLY COMPLAINT OF THIS TYPE TO COME TO OUR ATTENTION" END QUOTE.

I WOULD LIKE TO CALL ATTENTION TO AN ARTICLE IN THE SUNNYVALE STANDARD, MAY 10TH., ABOUT THE 'BLOCK PARENT'. FOR THOSE WHO DID NOT SEE IT, HERE IS A BRIEF. PARENTS OF FAIR OAKS SCHOOL SET UP A SAFETY AND PROTECTION PROGRAM FOR THEIR CHILDREN IN THE FORM OF A VOLUNTEER OR 'BLOCK PARENT', IDENTIFIABLE BY THE CHILDREN OR ANYONE BY A CARD IN THEIR WINDOW, RULES ON THE BACK OF CARD AS TO WHAT THE VOLUNTEER MAY OR MAY NOT DO FOR THE CHILD.

THIS CARD IN THE WINDOW COULD ALSO BE AN "OUNCE OF PREVENTION".

THE 'BLOCK PARENT' HAS AN ALTERNATE IN THE EVENT SHE MUST BE AWAY FOR ANY LENGTH OF TIME.

BY ACQUAINTING OUR CHILDREN WITH THIS SAFETY AND PROTECTION PROGRAM AND POINTING OUT THE CARDS IN THE WINDOWS, IF WE ADOPT IT, WILL GIVE THEM A PLACE TO GO, IF THEY ARE BOTHERED IN ANY WAY.

HAVING A 'BLOCK PARENT' SAFETY AND PROTECTION PROGRAM IN OUR AREA WOULD NOT MEAN THAT OUR CHILDREN WERE ARE GOOD OR BAD, IT DOES MEAN THAT OUR CHILDREN ARE HEALTHY AND GROWING AND THAT IN THE EVENT THAT SOME CHILD NEEDS PROTECTION IT ALSO MEANS ANOTHER CHILD NEEDS A LESSON IN BROTHERHOOD AND GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP.

WOULD YOU LIKE MORE PROTECTION FOR YOUR CHILD?

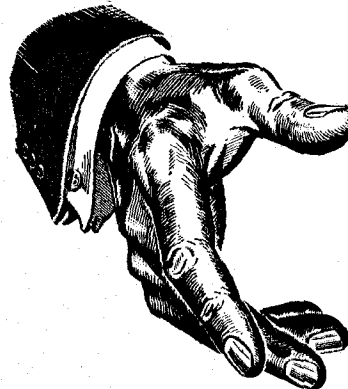

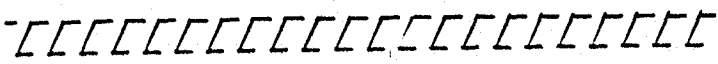
AFRICAN VIOLETS AT HOME

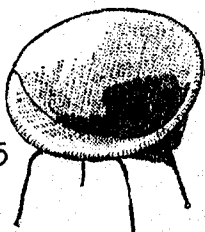

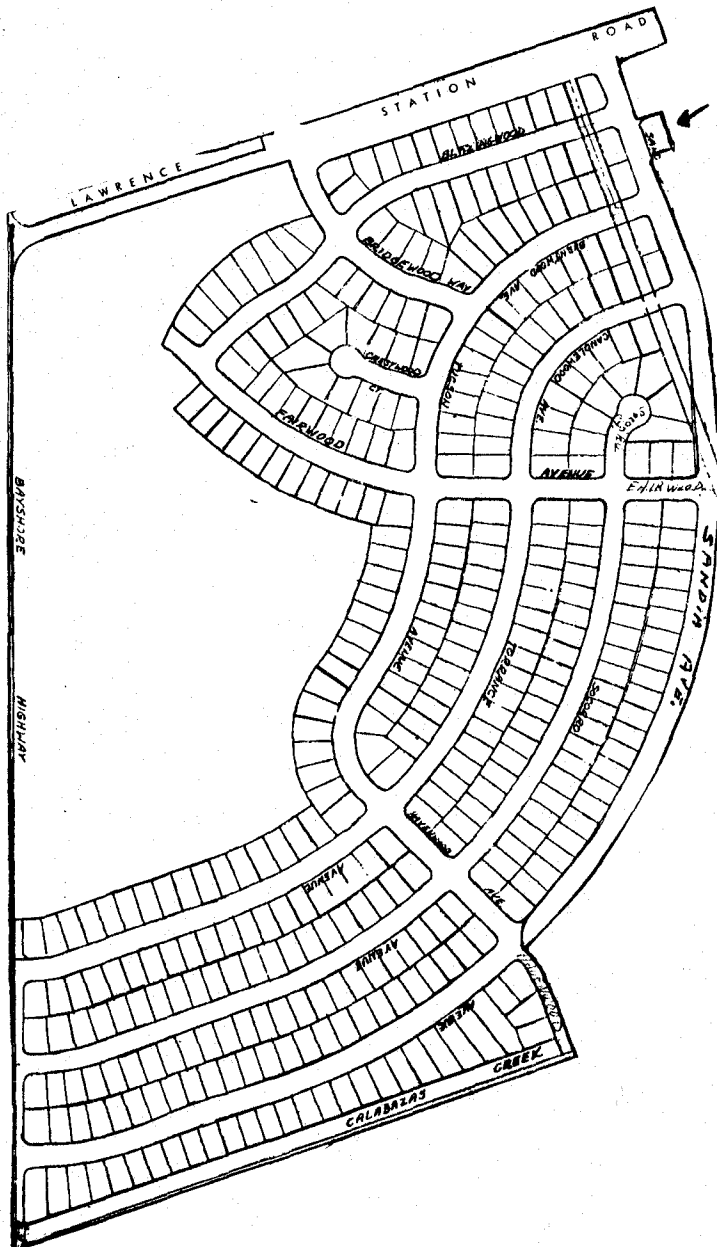

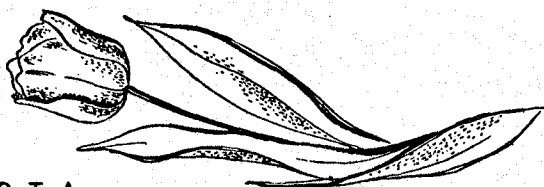
BE SURE TO KEEP IT CLEAN AND LINT AND DUST FREE AT ALL TIMES.

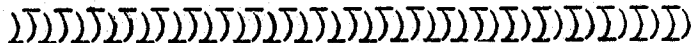

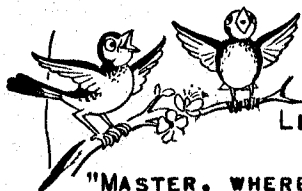


