



# BAYSIDE SCHOOL ON SCHEDULE

THE CONSTRUCTION OF BAYSIDE SCHOOL IS PROCEEDING ON SCHEDULE ACCORDING TO DR. GLEN VIRT, ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS, AND SHOULD BE READY FOR OCCUPANCY IN NOVEMBER OR DECEMBER.

THE 15 ACRE SITE LOCATED AT HIDDENLAKE AND LAKEBIRD DRIVES IS BEING BUILT TO ACCOMMODATE STUDENTS FROM THE GREATER ORCHARD GARDENS AREA AND A PORTION OF LAKEWOOD VILLAGE. THE NEW KINDERGARTEN THROUGH SIXTH GRADE SCHOOL WILL ALLOW ALL CHILDREN OF THOSE GRADES TO ATTEND SCHOOL WITHOUT HAVING TO CROSS BAYSHORE

THE SCHOOL WILL CONSIST OF TWO KINDERGARTEN ROOMS, 12 REGULAR CLASSROOMS, AND ADDITIONAL SPACE FOR 6 MORE CLASSROOMS SHOULD THE NEED FOR THEM ARISE IN THE FUTURE. THE BUILDING WILL ALSO HAVE A LIBRARY, TEACHERS AND ADMINISTRATIVE ROOMS, MULTI-PURPOSE ROOM, AND A CAFETERIA. THE TWELVE CLASSROOMS ARE BEING COMPLETED FIRST SO THAT THE CHILDREN MAY OCCUPY THE BUILDING WITHOUT WAITING FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE MULTI-PURPOSE AREA.

THE SCHOOL DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION, UNDER THE ABLE LEADERSHIP OF DR. HENRY MOLINO, ARE IN THE MEANTIME DOING ALL THAT IS POSSIBLE TO MAINTAIN AN ATMOSPHERE AS NORMAL AS POSSIBLE FOR THE BAYSIDE STUDENTS FOR THE FEW MONTHS BEFORE THE BUILDING IS READY FOR OCCUPANCY.

THE STUDENTS WILL BE HOUSED IN VARIOUS SCHOOLS THROUGHOUT THE DISTRICT. THE CHILDREN WILL BE PLACED IN CLASSES WITH THE TEACHER THEY WILL HAVE AT BAYSIDE. UPON BAYSIDE'S COMPLETION THE CLASS AND TEACHER WILL BE MOVED AS A BODY TO THE NEW LOCATION. THIS WILL PREVENT A DISRUPTION OF THE TEACHING PROCEDURE AND THE ONLY CHANGE WILL BE A GEOGRAPHICAL ONE.

THE TENTATIVE PLAN IS TO TEMPORARILY HOUSE THE STUDENTS AS FOLLOWS: ALL KINDERGARTEN AND A PORTION OF THE FIRST GRADE AT LAKEWOOD SCHOOL. THE REMAINDER OF THE FIRST, ALL SECOND, AND A PART OF THE THIRD GRADES AT BISHOP. THE REMAINDER OF THE THIRD AND SOME OF THE FOURTH AT FAIR OAKS. A FOURTH AND FIFTH AT MORSE. A FIFTH AND ALL SIXTH GRADE AT ADAIR.

THE DISTRICT WILL INFORM EACH PARENT BY LETTER, DURING THE FIRST WEEK IN SEPT., WHICH SCHOOL THEIR CHILD OR CHILDREN WILL ATTEND AND ALSO WHAT THE BUS SCHEDULES WILL BE.

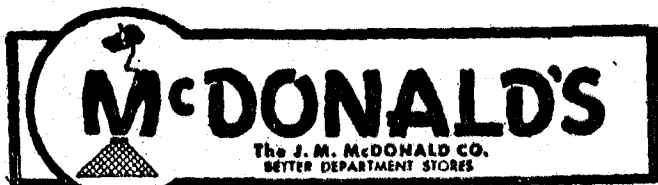

PERILOUS PLANTS

COMMON, YET DANGEROUS SHRUBS WHICH ARE WIDELY USED ARE CASTOR BEAN AND OLEANDER. THE CASTOR BEAN PRODUCES RICH FOLIAGE WHICH IS FINE FOR TROPICAL EFFECTS. THE POISON IS FORMED IN THE SEED ITSELF, AN ATTRACTIVELY COLORED BEAN WHICH IS PRODUCED IN CLUSTERS AT THE TIP OF BRANCHES. TO BE SAFE, RE-

MOVE THESE SEEDS AS THEY BEGIN TO GROW. ALTHOUGH THE FOLIAGE ITSELF MAY CAUSE SKIN IRRITATION TO SUSCEPTIBLE PERSONS, IT IS NOT CONSIDERED DANGEROUS.

THE OLEANDER IS AN OUTSTANDING SHRUB FOR USE IN ALL PARTS OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA. ITS FOLIAGE AND FLOWERS GRACE MANY STREETS AND HIGHWAYS SINCE IT IS WELL ADAPTED FOR HOT, DRY LOCATIONS. ALL PARTS OF OLEANDER ARE POISONOUS. LEAVES, FLOWERS, AND BRANCHES SHOULD NEVER BE EATEN, CHEWED, OR USED AS KINDLING FOR BARBECUES. EVEN THE SMOKE IS CONSIDERED IRRITATING.

THERE ARE HUNDREDS OF POISONOUS PLANTS WHICH WILL CAUSE SICKNESS OR SKIN IRRITATIONS. THESE INCLUDE AMARYLLIS, BOXWOOD, CANARYBIRD BUSH, DELPHINIUM OR LARKSPUR, POINSETTIA, GINKGO TREE, ENGLISH IVY, HYDRANGEA, HOLLY, IMPATIENS, LOBELIA, NARCISSUS, PRIMROSE, AZALEAS, AND RHODODENDRONS, NIGHTSHADE AND YEW. IN MOST CASES THESE PLANTS MERELY CAUSE SHIN IRRITATION WHEN HANDLED EXTENSIVELY.

IT IS IMPRACTICAL TO ELIMINATE FROM YOUR GARDEN ALL PLANTS REPORTED TO BE DANGEROUS, UNLESS EVERYONE TAKES THE SAME MEASURES. IT IS FAR BETTER TO TEACH CHILDREN NEVER TO EAT ANYTHING FROM THE GARDEN UNLESS IT BE A RECOGNIZED FRUIT OR VEGETABLE.

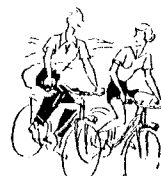
