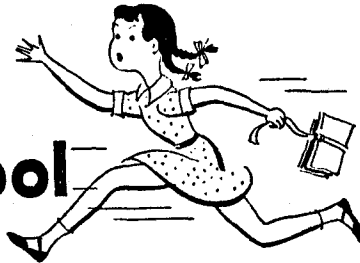

"NINE OUT OF TEN SEX PSYCHOPATHS IN CALIFORNIA ARE STILL WALKING THE STREETS AMONG US...RARELY SUSPECTED AND EXCEPTIONALLY NORMAN IN APPEARANCE."(1) HOW CAN THIS HAPPEN? SUNBURN

SUNBURN IS CAUSED MAINLY BY ULTRAVIOLET RAYS. A SLIGHT OVEREXPOSURE CAUSES TINY BLOOD VESSELS IN THE SKIN TO ENLARGE; THE SKIN BECOMES RED. AS OVEREXPOSURE INCREASES, TISSUE INJURY STARTS, SWELLING OF THE SKIN OCCURS, BLISTERS APPEAR, AND OFTEN FEVER AND HEAD-ACHE DEVELOP.

PREVENTION. SEVERE SUNBURN CAUSES GREAT DISCOMFORT AND MAY REQUIRE BED REST FOR MANY DAYS. THE MOST EFFECTIVE PREVENTION LIES IN LIMITING THE TIME OF INITIAL EXPOSURES. THE FIRST EXPOSURE SHOULD NOT BE LONGER THAN 10-15 MINUTES. ON SEA AND LAKE SHORES AND AT HIGH ALTITUDES, THE INCREASE OF ESPOSURE TIME SHOULD BE GRADUAL; ABOUT 1/3 OF THE PREVIOUS TIME IF SUNBATHS ARE TAKEN DAILY, AND 1/4 OR LESS IF EXPOSURES ARE LESS FREQUENT. SUNBURN MAY FOLLOW EXPOSURE ON A CLOUDY DAY.

COMMERCIAL PREPARATIONS FOR PROTECTION AGAINST SUNBURN VARY IN THEIR EFFECTS. SOME HAVE HARDLY ANY PROTECTING EFFECTS; OTHERS ARE HIGHLY EFFECTIVE BUT MAY CAUSE ALLERGIC REACTIONS.

FIRST AID FOR MILD SUNBURN, COLD CREAM OR SUCH OILS OR GREASES AS SALAD OIL OR SHORTENING MAY RELIEVE PAIN. WASH THE HANDS BEFORE APPLYING MATERIAL TO AVOID INFECTION. MEDICATED CREAMS MAY CAUSE SKIN ALLERGIES. BUTTER OR OLEDMARGARINE SHOULD NOT BE APPLIED BECAUSE OF THE SALT CONTENT.

A DRESSING SHOULD BE USED IF BLISTERING APPEARS. MEDICAL CARE IS NEEDED FOR EXTENSIVE AND SEVERE CASES. THE INJURED AREA SHOULD NOT BE EXPOSED AGAIN TO THE SUN UNTIL HEALING IS COMPLETED.

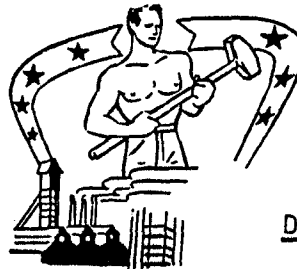

- 1/2 cup coarsely diced celery
- 1/2 cup sliced onion
