FIRE STATION Under Way

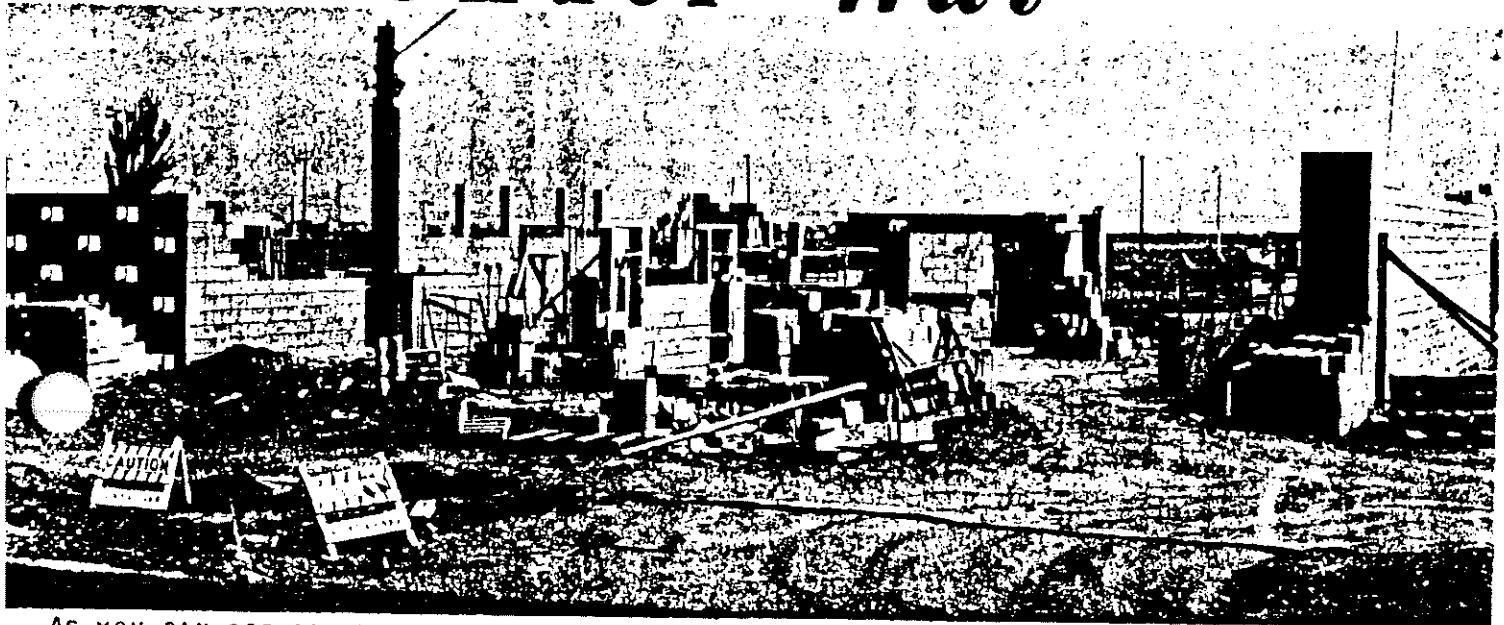

OUR OFFICIAL GREETER WAS A GROUP OF DONKIES AND A REAL BRIGHT TOTUM POLE. VOTER INFORMATION

Before the date of the election you must be

- a U. S. citizen
- past 21 years of age
- a California resident at least one year
- a resident of Santa Clara County at least 90 days
- a resident of your precinct at least 54 days
- able to read English and write your own name.

REGISTER ONLY ONCE -- unless

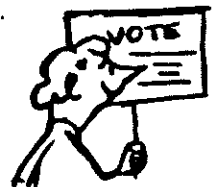
- you move, or
- you fail to vote in BOTH the state-wide primary AND the November general elections in even-numbered years, or
- you change your name, or
- you change your party affiliation.

WHEN YOU REGISTER,

you'll be asked to state your political party. You don't have to tell, but IF YOU DON'T, you'll have no voice in choosing candidates at the primaries.

IF YOU DO state a party affiliation, you'll receive that party's ballot when you go to the primaries in June.

If you cannot register in person, phone or write to the Registrar of Voters for information. CYPRESS 5-1050
If you cannot get to your polling place on election day for physical or geographical reasons, WRITE to the Registrar of Voters for an absentee ballot not more than 20 days, nor less than 5 days before election day.

THE THREE ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS IN LAKEWOOD VILLAGE ARE REACHING THE ENROLLMENT SATURATION POINT!

ON SEPTEMBER 20TH, THE SUNNYVALE SCHOOL DISTRICT RELEASED IT'S STUDY ON ENROLLMENT PATTERNS. THIS REPORT REFLECTED STATISTICALLY WHAT PARENTS AND TEACHERS IN THE VILLAGE AREA ALREADY KNOW: THE SCHOOLS ARE CROWDED!

RECOGNITION OF THE SITUATION HAS PROMPTED THE DISTRICT TO TAKE THE FOLLOWING ACTION:

BAYSIDE:

1. HIRE A HALFTIME KINDERGARTEN TEACHER.
2. TRANSFER 20 TO 23 FIRST GRADERS TO LAKEWOOD.

AIRWOOD:

1. HIRE A TEACHER TO RELIEVE THE LARGE FIRST GRADE ENROLLMENT.
2. EMPLOY A CLASSIFIED TEACHERS AID TO ASSIST IN KINDERGARTENS.

LAKEWOOD:

1. TRANSFER 5 TO 8 SIXTH GRADERS TO BAYSIDE
2. EMPLOY A CLASSIFIED TEACHERS AID TO ASSIST IN KINDERGARTENS.

THE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS FELT THAT THE TRANSFER OF STUDENTS AND THE EMPLOYMENT OF THE ADDITIONAL TEACHER AND TEACHER AIDES WOULD BRING THE CLASS SIZE WITHIN THE DISTRICT NORM OF 28-32 STUDENTS.

MRS. GENEVIEVE TINKER IS THE MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN AND ANNOUNCED THE MEMBERSHIP DRIVE WILL BEGIN OCTOBER 8TH THROUGH THE 19TH. PLANS FOR THE CARNIVAL ARE "WELL UNDER WAY", SAYS MR. 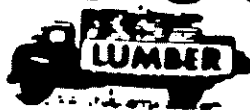
