Tax Increase

A SKELETAL BUDGET FOR 1963-64 SCHOOL YEAR REFLECTS A \$450,000 DEFICIT, BASED ON EXPECTED INCOME COMPARED TO NORMAL EXPENDITURES INCLUDING THE REINSTATEMENT OF SPECIAL PROGRAMS WHICH WERE CUT IN LAST YEAR'S BUDGET BONDS. TO MEET THIS FINANCIAL CRISIS, IT APPEARS LIKELY THAT THE BOARD WILL CALL FOR AN INCREASE IN TAXES THROUGH AN APRIL 16TH ELECTION. THE MOST FREQUENTLY MENTIONED INCREASE, IS 25%, TO BOOST THE RATE BASE TO \$2.45 PER \$1 OF ASSESSED VALUATION.
