



L.V.R.A. OFFICERS TO BE NOMINATED

MR. ED LEVINE, SANTA CLARA COUNTY SUPERVISOR WAS THE GUEST SPEAKER AT THE JANUARY GENERAL MEETING OF THE L.V.R.A.

MR. LEVINE SPOKE ON THE ADVANTAGES OF THE COUNTY PURCHASING THE AIRPOINT RESERVOIR SITE NEAR MILPITAS FOR A COUNTY PARK. HE POINTED OUT THAT THE STATE NOW OWNS THE LAND WHICH IS APPROXIMATELY 575 ACRES AND INCLUDES THE SPRING VALLEY GOLF COURSE. MR. LEVINE STATED THAT THE COUNTY CAN NOW PURCHASE THE PROPERTY FOR LESS THAN THE STATE ORIGINALLY PAID FOR IT SOME TIME AGO. THE AREA, HE FEELS IS THE LAST REMAINING AREA IN SANTA CLARA COUNTY THAT IS SUITABLE FOR A LARGE PARK. WITH THE RAPID GROWTH OF THE AREA AND WITH AN ESTIMATED POPULATION OF MORE THAN TWO MILLION PEOPLE WITHIN A FEW YEARS IN THE COUNTY, HE FEELS THAT WE CANNOT AFFORD NOT TO PURCHASE AND DEVELOPE THIS INTO A PARK.

THE PARK WOULD CONTINUE TO OPERATE THE GOLF COURSE FOR THE PUBLIC. A LAKE WOULD BE BUILT FOR SMALL BOATS, FISHING AND SWIMMING. PICNIC AREAS, A RIFLE RANGE, ARCHERY RANGE, HIKING TRAILS, RIDING TRAILS AND MANY OTHER SPORTS COULD BE UNDERTAKEN WITHIN THE PARK.

THE RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION HAS BEEN INTERESTED IN THE PARK AREA FOR SOME TIME. THIS IS THE SAME AREA THAT WAS TO BE DEVELOPED INTO A LARGE RESERVOIR FOR STORAGE OF THE SOUTH BAY AQUEDUCT WATER. IT WAS FOUND AFTER MUCH STUDY THAT A LARGE LAKE COULD NOT BE BUILT AT THIS LOCATION BECAUSE OF THE ROCK AND FORMATION IN THE HILLS WHERE THE DAM WOULD BE CONSTRUCTED. THE ASSOCIATION WENT ON RECORD SUPPORTING THE PURCHASE OF THIS LAND AND WISHES ALL RESIDENTS IN THE VILLAGE TO CALL ONE OR MORE OF THE COUNTY SUPERVISORS AND MAKE KNOWN OUR DESIRE. WE ONLY HAVE UNTIL APRIL 6TH TO PURCHASE THIS LAND AND IF WE DO NOT MOVE FAST AND TAKE IT NOW THE STATE WILL SELL IT TO PRIVATE DEVELOPERS.

OPERS. MANY OF THESE WOULD BE DEVELOPERS DO NOT WANT THE COUNTY TO PURCHASE THE LAND AS THEY THEMSELVES WANT TO BUILD HOUSES ON THIS BEAUTIFUL LAND.

THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE IS HARD AT WORK SELECTING CANDIDATES FOR THE FORTHCOMING ELECTION. THE NOMINEES WILL BE PRESENTED AT THE FEBRUARY MEETING, FEBRUARY 3RD. NOMINEES THE FEBRUARY MEETING (3RD). NOMINATIONS WILL BE MADE FROM THE FLOOR AT THE MEETING. THE ELECTION OF NEW OFFICERS WILL BE HELD IN MARCH. WE ARE LOOKING FORWARD TO A FINE GROUP OF CANDIDATES, THIS YEAR TO KEEP YOUR ASSOCIATION MOVING AHEAD WITH VIGOR.



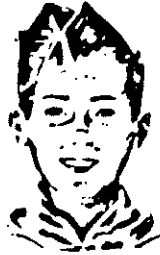

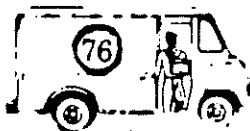
