

THIS PAPER DESIRES TO ESTABLISH A MONTHLY COLUMN DEVOTED TO HELPING SOLVE THE SEASONAL AND ADOBE SOIL PROBLEMS THAT DAMAGE SO MANY OF THE AMATEUR GARDNER'S ATTEMPTS IN THE VILLAGE. MONTH TO MONTH UPKEEP AND PLANTING PROGRAMS WILL BE PRESENTED.

INTRODUCING, ALBERT THE GARDNER, MR. ALBERT CAMICIA OF 1151 STONYLAKE COURT WHO WILL MAKE THIS COLUMN GROW. WHEN HE IS NOT DRIVING A BIG TRUCK, THIS 4 YEAR VILLAGER IS A MAN WITH A GREEN THUMB.

THIS MONTH

BEFORE THE HEAVY MARCH RAINS COME, THE LAWNS AND OPEN SOIL AREAS SHOULD BE CONDITIONED FOR THE YEAR AHEAD. MANY LAWNS REMAIN UNWATERED EVEN THOUGH THEY ARE COMING OUT OF THEIR DORMANT WINTER STAGE. WITH THE INCREASING SUN TIME THEY SHOULD BE WATERED NOW BEFORE THEY TURN BROWN AND THE SOIL CRACKS WAITING FOR THE SPRING RAINS. AFTER THE SOIL HAS BEEN WATERED TO SOFTEN IT UP, A COUPLE OF DAYS LATER BEFORE THE RAINS, FERTILIZER AND PEAT MOSS SHOULD BE WORKED INTO THE SOIL WITH A PITCHFORK OR A RENTED ROTOTILLER.

BEST PLANTS

ONE OF THE BEST ALL AROUND TYPES OF PLANTS FOR THIS SOIL AND DAILY TEMPERATURE FLUCTUATIONS IS THE EVERGREEN TYPE. PLANTING IN AUGUST THEY WILL THRIVE IN THE ADOBE SOIL WHEN A SMALL AMOUNT OF FERTILIZER IS WORKED IN BY THE ROOTS.

MANY PETUNIAS SEEM TO HAVE SURVIVED THE WARMER WINTER THIS YEAR. THEY SHOULD BE TRIMMED BACK NOW UNTIL A FEW LEAVES AND SHORT STEMS REMAIN.

UNIFICATION OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS ?

THE SUNNYVALE BOARD OF EDUCATION, THOUGH IN FAVOR OF UNIFICATION IN PRINCIPLE, OPPOSES THE UNIFICATION OF THE CUPERTINO AND SUNNYVALE ELEMENTARY DISTRICTS WITHIN THE FREMONT UNION HIGH DISTRICTS FOR THE FOLLOWING:

1. THE CITIZEN'S ADVISORY COMMITTEE, AFTER A YEAR OF STUDY, RECOMMENDED TO THE REDISTRICTING COMMITTEE THAT THE FREMONT UNION HIGH SCHOOL, SUNNYVALE AND CUPERTINO UNION SCHOOL DISTRICTS BE REORGANIZED INTO TWO UNIFIED DISTRICTS. THE SUNNYVALE BOARD SUPPORTS THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE COMMITTEE.
2. IN A JOINTLY FINANCED STUDY AUTHORIZED BY THE THREE BOARDS THE FOLLOWING RECOMMENDATIONS WERE MADE:

- A. THE SURVEY STAFF RECOMMENDS THAT THE COUNTY COMMITTEE ON SCHOOL DISTRICT ORGANIZATION DEVELOP A PLAN CALLING FOR AN ELECTION FOR UNIFICATION OF THE FREMONT DISTRICT.
- B. IF THE THREE GOVERNING BOARDS CANNOT AGREE ON A PLAN IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT TWO ELECTIONS BE HELD CONCURRENTLY IN THE TWO ELEMENTARY DISTRICTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF FORMING A UNIFIED DISTRICT ON THE BOUNDARIES OF EACH ELEMENTARY DISTRICT.
