THE "DEDICATION DAY CEREMONIES" FOR LAKEWOOD VILLAGE'S SPACE AGE PARK, CO-SPONSORED BY THE L.V.R.A. AND THE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT OF SUNNYVALE, ARE SCHEDULED TO "BLAST OFF" AT 1:30 P.M. ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 12TH.

STARTING CEREMONIES WILL BE HEADED BY THE LOCAL SCOUTING GROUPS AND THE PRESENTATION OF THE FLAG WILL BE PERFORMED BY A REPRESENTATIVE FROM EACH GROUP.

WE HAD A LOT OF TROUBLE THIS SUMMER WITH TEENAGERS FROM OTHER SECTIONS OF TOWN. THE LEADERS AT THE CLUB REQUIRED CARDS BUT SOME OF THESE KIDS WOULD HANG AROUND OUTSIDE THE CLUB UNTIL IT WAS OVER AND PICK UP THE GIRLS. SOME OF THE LANGUAGE THAT WAS USED WOULD MAKE YOUR HAIR STAND ON END. I KNOW FOR A FACT BECAUSE I WAS THERE, THAT THIS LANGUAGE WAS NOT ALLOWED INSIDE AND IF MR. CARROL HEARD ANY OF IT THE KIDS WERE ASKED TO LEAVE BUT HIS JOB IS INSIDE THE CLUB AND IF YOUR DAUGHTER LEFT EARLY SHE WAS EXPOSED TO THIS ON MANY OCCASIONS. DON'T KEEP YOUR CHILDREN HOME, THIS

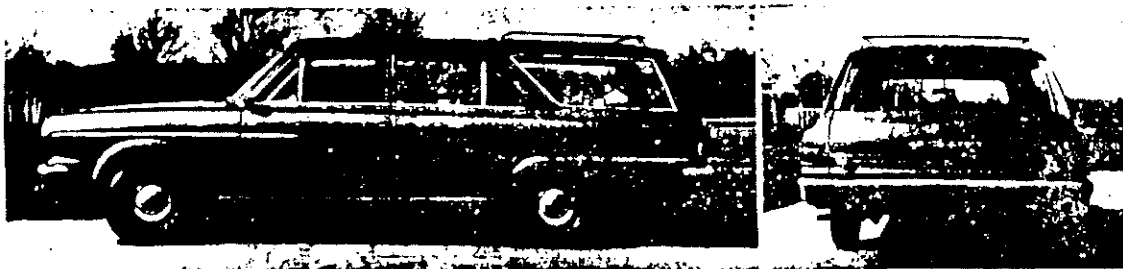

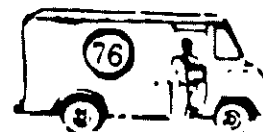
