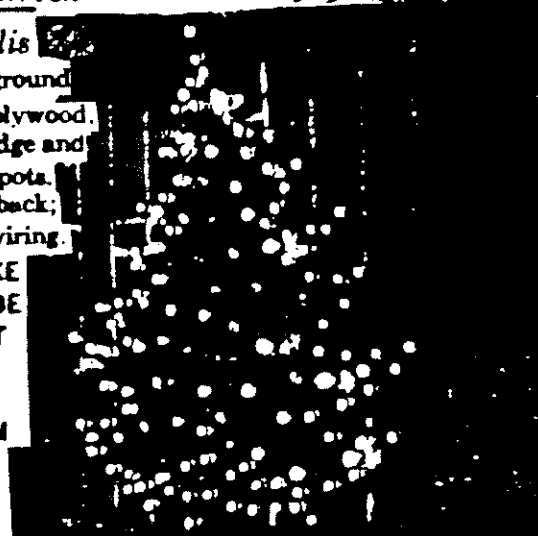

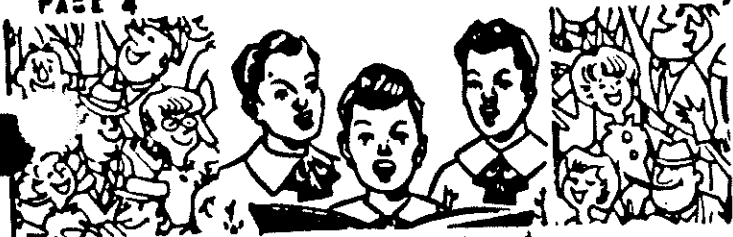

I FEEL GUILTY. IT HAS BEEN MANY YEARS NOW I FAILED TO OBSERVE THANKSGIVING DAY GOING TO CHURCH.

FOR YEARS I HAVE DEPLORED THE INDIFFERENCE OF OTHERS TO THIS MEANINGFUL RELIGIOUS HOLIDAY. NOW IT HAS HAPPENED TO ME.

NOBODY IN OUR CHURCH SUGGESTED HAVING A SERVICE. I WAITED FOR SOME WORD OF A COMMUNITY SERVICE SPONSORED BY THE MINISTERS OR CHURCHES OF THE COMMUNITY. NONE CAME.
