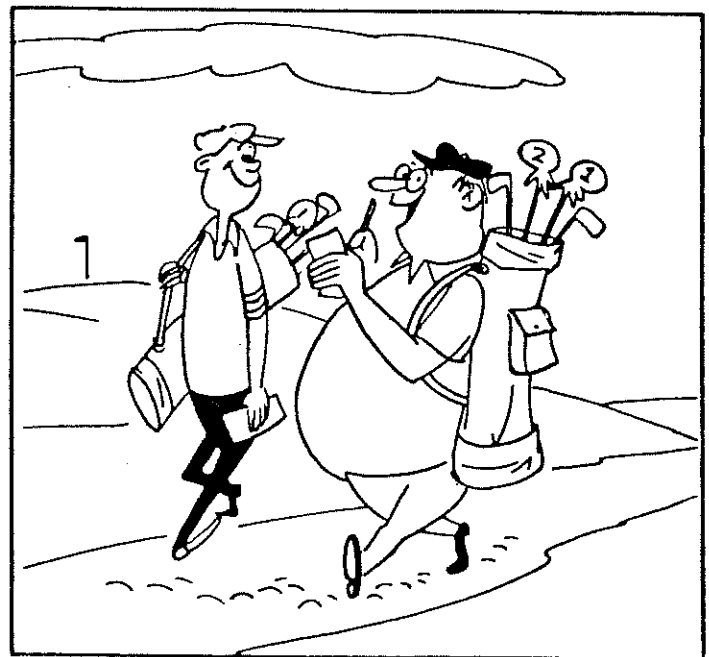

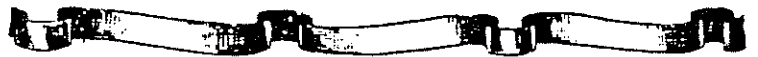

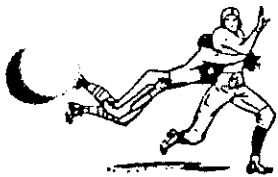
STEVE MANLEY, CAME TO SUNNYVALE WITH A VERY HIGH RECOMENDATION FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF STANFOR, WHERE HE IS A GRADUATE LAW STUDENT. THE STANFORD TUTORING DEPARTMENT REFERRED HIM TO SUNNYVALE BECAUSE THEY FELT OUR SCHOOL DISTRICT WOULD BE THE MOST RECEPTIVE TO THIS TYPE OF PROGRAM, AND THE DISTRICT IN TURN, REFERRED HIM TO OUR VILLAGE BECAUSE THEY FELT OUR THREE SCHOOLS WOULD BE THE MOST HELPFUL TO HIM AND THE PEOPLE OF OUR VILLAGE WOULD BE THE MOST ENTHUSIASTIC.

STEVE, A NATIVE OF SAN DIEGO, HAS A B.A. DEGREE IN BEHAVOURIAL SCIENCE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA. THIS DEGREE IS A COMBINATION OF PSYCHOLOGY AND SOCIOLOGY, THAT IS GIVEN AT ONLY TWO UNIVERSITIES IN THE COUNTRY. HE WILL GRADUATE FROM STANFORD LAW SCHOOL IN JUNE WITH AN L.L.B.

WHILE AT BERKLEY, HE WORKED IN A PROGRAM FOR EMOTIONALLY DISTURBED CHILDREN UNDER A GRANT FROM THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF MENTAL HEALTH.

HE WAS EMPLOYED BY THE BAYSIDE SETTLEMENT HOUSE IN SAN DIEGO, TO RUN A RECREATIONAL PROGRAM SIMILAR TO THE PROGRAM HE HAS INTRODUCED IN THE VILLAGE.

CURRENTLY HE IS WORKING WITH JUVENILES THROUGH THE COURT AND IS WAS WORKING WITH THESE BOYS, PLUS THE BOYS IN THE OTHER ABOVE MENTICNED PROGRAMS THAT CONVINCED STEVE THAT A PROGRAM OF THIS NATURE WOULD BE OF GREAT VALUE.



AFTER GRADUATING, STEVE PLANS TO SETTLE IN THIS AREA AND CONTINUE HIS PROGRAM.

THE PROGRAM IS AIMED PRIMARILY AT BOYS WHO ARE NOT ACTIVELY INVOLVED IN SCOUTING, LITTLE LEAGUE OR Y.M.C.A.

HORIZONS, THE NAME OF THE CLUB, IS UNIQUE IN THAT THE ACTIVITIES OF THE CLUB ARE SUGGESTED AND PLANNED BY THE BOYS. NO STRICT RULES ARE ENFORCED BUT FAIRNESS AND MUTUAL RESPECT ARE STRESSED. THEY MEET ON TUESDAYS AND THURSDAYS AT 3:45 P.M. TO PLAN OUTINGS AND ENGAGE IN SPORT ACTIVITIES. ON SATURDAYS THEY GO ON EXCURSIONS.

MANY HIGHLY QUALIFIED ASSISTANTS HAVE BEEN LINED UP TO ASSIST WITH THE PROGRAM FOR THE SUMMER. TRANSPORTATION IS ONE OF THE MAJOR EXPENCES AT THE PRESENT.

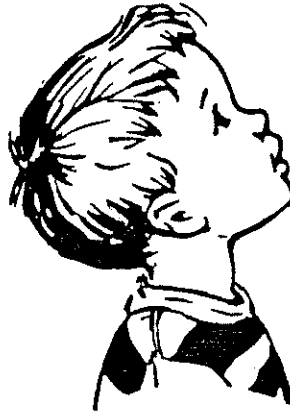

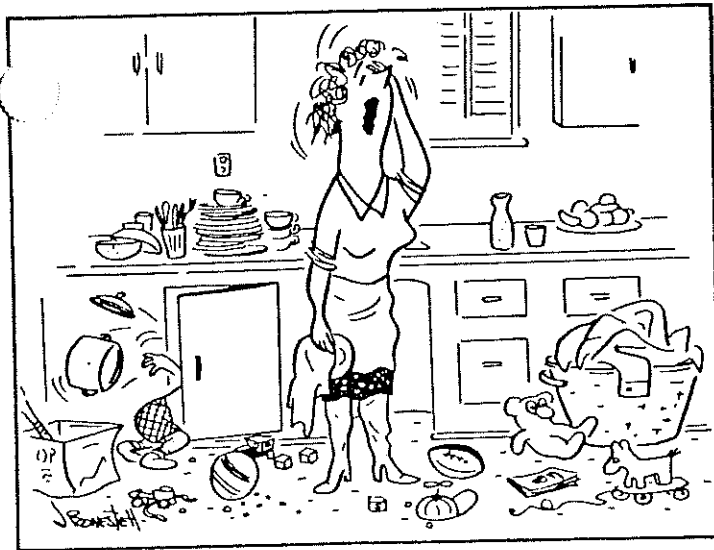
