LAKWOOD VILLAGE QUEEN CONTEST

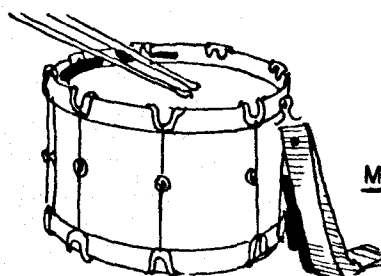

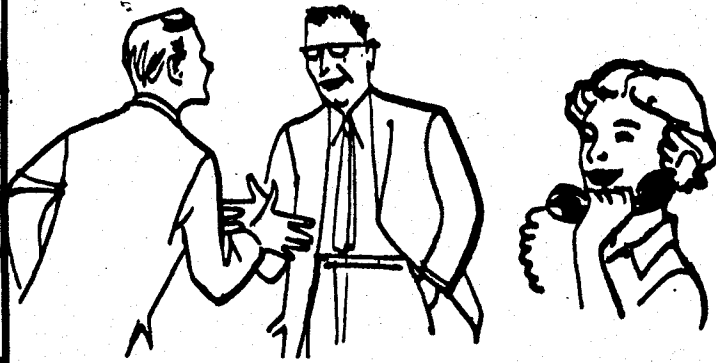
